## Some definitions and guidance for IPMA agricultural storage inspections:


- Commercial pesticides: these will have the word "COMMERCIAL", "AGRICULTURAL", or "INDUSTRIAL" on the label. These are concentrated pesticides that require dilution and mixing, and specialized spray equipment like an airblast sprayer for application. The majority of pesticides used in agriculture are commercial products. Common examples in agriculture include Diazinon, Cygon, Roundup, Captan, etc.
- Restricted pesticides: these will have the word "RESTRICTED" on the label. These are typically highly-toxic
  pesticides, and a grower is required to have a valid pesticide applicator certificate in order to purchase and use these
  products. The two most common Restricted pesticides used in agricultural today are Guthion (azinphos-methyl) and
  Gopher Getter (strychnine).
- Domestic pesticides: Domestic pesticides have the word "DOMESTIC" on the label. These are generally premixed and ready to use pesticides available at hardware stores or garden centres, such as Roundup, Killex, Pounce, etc. They are generally used by homeowners for non-commercial purposes.
- P.C.P. number: this is the federal Pest Control Products Act registration number. Every pesticide registered in Canada has one, and it is found on the front panel of the pesticide label.
- Storage requirements: All Commercial and Restricted pesticides must be stored in a facility that is locked, signed, and vented. These requirements do <u>not</u> apply to Domestic pesticides. Storage requirements also do <u>not</u> apply to pesticides that are mixed and loaded into the tank of a sprayer.
- Venting requirements for storage: in general, either active venting (e.g. a powered fan) or passive venting (e.g. holes or cracks that allow some air flow) are acceptable for a storage shed.
- Presence of Obsolete or Unwanted Pesticides: it is legal for the grower to store properly-labelled obsolete
  pesticides in a compliant storage facility. We collect contact information for those with obsolete pesticides, and send
  them a reminder to dispose of their products at free disposals that occur approximately every five years.
- Digital photos: Photos of the inspection are important, including pictures of the storage area, and photos of the front label of any pesticides present in order to verify the pesticide name and PCP number.

Any other situation with a high level of risk to human health and/or the environment (e.g. pesticides stored beside a child's toys, storage close to a stream or other waterbody, etc.), discuss with IPM staff. Non-compliance can be charged under Section 3 (1) (a) of the IPM Act – store pesticide in a manner causing or likely to cause an unreasonable adverse effect.


