2014-07-31 08:54 hrs CO Owens notified of occurrence by ECC. 09:00 hrs C/n contacted advising california mountain sheep ram believed to of been hit by motor vehicle and injured. Ram bedded paved surface of westside road south of Fintry. 09:05 hrs CO Owens 10-17 occurrence location. 10:00 hrs CO locates ram aprox 3 km north of Secret point. Ram observed east of westside road 20 yards down a private driveway to lake access. Ram iniatially observed bedded sternum position with head outstretched in a lowered position. As ram approached ram got up standing with legs outstretched and discoordinated. Head outstretched in a lowered position. Ram observed running 100 yards down driveway then bedding in sternum position in front of two fith wheel trailers. Ram appeared injured with breathing constricted. Ram humaneley euthanized. Time permitting ram will be skinned to determine if vehicle cause of injury. Provincial vet 10:19 hrs Helen Schwantje adviced of occurrence. Head and possibly lungs will be retained from ram for further inspection by provincial vet or regional wildlife staff. 10:45 hrs CO removes ram from occurrence location. Considering high heat tempatures 38 degrees and PAT response Armstrong ram carcass disposed of with only head retained. 2014-08-01 08:30 hrs CI 117645 completed related to ram. E-mail sent to Andrew walker, regional wildlife biologist advising of occurrence. HWCR concluded.
