Re: Non-compliance Advisory Letter, PE-1777

I am writing this letter to inform you of a current non-compliance with section 2 of your permit, PE-1777. Section 2 outlines the requirement to post security for your site. The full amount of security was to be phased in over a three-year period as follows:

- a) Year 1 (by July 29, 2011) \_provide \$23,000;
- b) Year 2 (by July 31, 2012) provide \$23,000; and,
- c) Year 3 (by July 31, 2013) provide and maintain full security of \$69,000.

As of today's date, July 21, 2014 no security has been posted for this site.

Security may be provided in one of two ways.

- "irrevocable letter of credit" (ILOC) is a letter of credit that neither the bank granting it nor the letter holder may cancel under any circumstances. An ILOC is a promise from a financial institution to the province that at the request of the province funds up to the agreed sum of money will be paid to the province. It can't be cancelled or amended and must automatically renew on expiry unless advance notice is provided to the province. It is an assured method of securing payment because the promise to pay is directly from the financial institution to the Ministry. In addition, an Irrevocable Letter of Credit allows for incremental additions each year should that be desired.
- "surety bond" A surety bond is a three-party agreement where the surety company promises to perform obligations of the bonded party or pay up to the agreed sum of money to the beneficiary if the bonded party fails to perform those obligations. Surety bonds are primarily used in construction because it is more suited to short-term projects. Depending on the obligations to be bonded, a renewable, longer term surety may be available. Like the Irrevocable Letter of Credit, a surety bond is irrevocable.

The overall purpose of financial security is to:

- Encourage sound projects by virtue of the maintenance of financial responsibility;
- Reduce risk to human health and the environment by ensuring accountability; and

 Mitigate the financial risk to government, agencies and the public by ensuring a regulated party has funds in place to deal with waste discharges and other waste management activities.

Failure to comply with the terms and conditions set out in your authorization is a violation under the Environmental Management Act (EMA)

A person who fails to comply with a provision of EMA may be found guilty of an offence and could be liable, on summary conviction, to a penalty. For your reference, EMA and all related and pertinent British Columbia Laws can be found at http://www.bclaws.ca/.

This Advisory, the alleged violations and the circumstances to which it refers will form part of the compliance history of 0849226 B.C. LTD (Edgewood Trailer Park) and its responsible officials and will be taken into account in the event of future non-compliance.

You are directed to do the following:

- 1. Implement the necessary changes or modifications immediately to address this situation and to bring it into compliance.
- 2. Notify this office by phone, email or letter within 30 days of this letter, advising what corrective measures have been taken, and what else is being done, to bring this authorization into compliance.

Please note that this authorization is considered out of compliance until such a time as it can be confirmed to meet the authorization requirements.

#### **Inspection Summary:**

On September 23, 2014 I inspected the Chetwynd Landfill and the property adjacent to the Chetwynd Landfill located at 3229 Blair Road, Chetwynd, BC, after receiving complaints of alleged dismantling of a number of vehicles at 3992 Blair Road without the required authorization or containment or practices. Photographs 1 and 2 attached were taken that support that more than 5 vehicles are onsite and appear to be in various stages of dismantling or crushing.

**Response:** Advisory

#### ACTIONS REQUIRED BY REGULATED PARTY:

Section 2 of Vehicle Dismantling and Recycling Industry Environmental Planning Regulation (VDRIEPR) requires an environmental management plan or registration for a facility that dismantles more than 5 wet vehicles in a calendar year. On September 23, 2014 there were more than 5 vehicles on site. Under section 8 of the VDRIEPR a person who fails to register when required commits an offence and is liable to a fine of up to \$200 000. The alleged vehicle dismantler at 3229 Blair Road, Chetwynd BC is not registered under the VDRIEPR and therefore not authorized to discharge waste related to vehicle dismantling until all registration requirements are met. Please comply with VDRIEPR if more than 5 wet vehicles are dismantled at this location. Visit

On September 23, 2014 the Chetwynd Landfill and the property adjacent to the Chetwynd Landfill located at 3229 Blair Road, Chetwynd, BC were inspected by staff of the Ministry of Environment, Environmental Protection Division.

Enclosed is an inspection record and photographs taken during the inspection of the Blair Road property. Please review the attached inspection record for further details on the inspection's findings.

It has come to the attention of the Ministry of Environment that the operation at the Blair Road property may be involved in recycling vehicles and vehicle parts - see the attached photographs showing more than five vehicles onsite. This letter is to confirm that this operation is currently not legally authorized to dismantle or crush more than five vehicles in a calendar year under British Columbia's *Environmental Management Act*, to wit the Vehicle Dismantling and Recycling Industry Environmental Planning Regulation.

The Vehicle Dismantling and Recycling Industry Environmental Planning Regulation reads in part:

- Section 2 (1) A person that operates or plans to operate a facility that dismantles more than five wet vehicles in a calendar year must:
  - (a) either: (i) have an environmental management plan for waste management, reduction or prevention, **or** 
    - (ii) be a member of an association that has an environmental management plan for waste management, reduction or prevention, **and**
  - (b) register with a director under section 3.
- A wet vehicle is defined as a vehicle that "is no longer used for transportation purposes and
  has not been reduced to a steel hulk or to a steel hulk with only the plastic, fabric or foam
  components still attached."

- Section 3 (1) A person described in section 2 (1) must register by providing all the following information to a director in a form approved by the director:
  - (a) the full legal name of the individual, partnership, corporation or other entity operating or planning to operate the facility;
  - (b) the name, address and telephone number of an individual who is located at or near the facility and is the local contact for the facility;
  - (c) the address of the facility and the legal description of the land on which the facility is located;
  - (d) the address at which the plan that applies to the facility may be viewed or copied;
  - (e) confirmation that the facility has a plan that complies with section 2 (3), or is a member of an association that has a plan that complies with section 2 (3) and the name, address and telephone number of that association;
  - (f) any other relevant information the discharger wishes to provide.
- (2) Registration under this section takes effect on the date a complete registration is received by a director.
- Section 8 (1) A person described in section 2 (1) who is not a member of an association commits
  an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine of not more \$200 000 if the person does any of
  the following:
  - (a) fails to have a plan when required under section 2 (2);
  - (b) fails to register with a director when required under section 2 (2);
  - (c) has a plan that contains false or misleading information;
  - (d) provides false or misleading information in a registration form;

In order to comply with the *Environmental Management Act* the vehicle dismantler at the Blair Road property must comply with the Vehicle Dismantling and Recycling Industry Environmental Planning Regulation.

This advisory, the alleged violations and the circumstances to which it refers will form part of the compliance history of the operation at the Blair Road property and its responsible officials and will be taken into account in the event of future non-compliance. You are directed to do the following:

- 1. Implement the necessary changes or modifications **immediately** to address this situation and to bring it into compliance.
- Notify this office by email or letter within 30 days of this letter, advising what corrective measures have been taken, and what else is being done, to bring this operation into compliance.
