BACKGROUND:

BDL submitted its Schedule 5 (PPP) stewardship plan for approval by November 19, 2012 as required. As with many plans, it was subject to a handful of recommended revisions over the next two years in order to meet Ministry requirements.






Distribution of water bottlers in BC




BC Water Bottler Industry Survey

- Service provider, BDL, distributes majority of beer in BC and collects
- beer containers (Sch. 1) and packaging (Sch. 5, pending approval) Deliver full goods to over 5,000 locations
- Stewardship is a part of our business (not arms length from production)
