2016-10-30 10:00 CO Popjes Ph.d COM and left msg. asking if his first issue had been reported and req. info/pics of extent of damage to garage door.

1200 COM returned ph. call and advised he spoke to a CO the first time a bear broke the garage door. COM stated the CO said 'what do you want me to do about it?' and 'the bears will be going to bed in the next two weeks'.

CO POPJES req. pics be sent of the damage to garage door. COM sent photos showing two panels pulled apart and scratches to other panels from bear. Door is a double wooden (cedar?) door. CO advised a trap would be set as soon as it could be arranged.

2016-11-01 1300 CO POPJES set trap on neighboring property for bear as it had level ground and was a better location-CO spoke with resident who approved of trap set and stated 'did not want this bear around'.

Bear level E3 on matrix-remove from population, ie. destroy.

COM saw bear as it poked its head through the garage and described it as a large black phase bb with a brown face. No ear tags.

2016-11-16 See HWCRC 16-21271, 16-21268 and 16-21264. RCMP responded and observed bear in back yard. Bear was lying down and upon approach it only moved its eyes to look at Cst. Cst. lit off a bear banger and bear got up slowly and walked away. Bear described as larger black phase bear with black face and no ear tags. CO Schumacher observed photo of damage to garage. Wooden panel garage door had one section boarded up previously and a larger two panels removed/damaged above the boarded up section.

CO Schumacher attended and re-baited trap.

2016-11-18 08:10 CO Schumacher received call from PEP advising that there was a bear in trap. (unable to find HWCRC for notification.)

08:30 CO Schumacher attended and spoke with resident who had damage to garage. Male advised that he observed bear go in trap just before the kids left for school. Male confirmed that it was the bear who broke into his garage four times. Bear large approx. 380lbs with dark brown/black face. Target bear for destruction.

CO Schumacher spoke with Sgt. MILLER and confirmed bear would be destroyed. CO destroyed large male bear and disposed of carcass with assistance from RCMP member. Suspected same bear that broke into bear on s.22 HWCRC 16-21160.

2016-11-15 0107 ECC advised of a bear in Whistler breaking into a garbage shed. ECC did not email through to CO. No CO response at time of call due to above and low public safety threat.

0926 CO ph.d ECC req. HWCR be emailed through-completed. CO ph.d COM who stated a black bear broke through their shed where garbage stored.

1240 CO Popjes 23 at residence. Garbage had been cleaned up. Bear damaged pedestrian door to 8' X 10' wooden shed with 2x4, plywood inner wall and wood siding outer wall structure. Bear tore a large hole through side of shed causing significant damage. CO spoke with several tenants in house who advised the owners were out of the country. Tenants did not want a trap set until they spoke to owners or property manager.

1500 COM ph.d CO back advising property management company stated a trap could be set if COS felt it was appropriate. COS planning to set trap tmr as likelihood high for repeated property damage, bear received a significant reward.

2016-11-17 CO POPJES attended and set LBT.

2016-11-19 10:14 CO Schumacher attended and spoke with female resident. No bear activity in the last couple days. CO advised that bear was caught on 5-22 (HWCR 16-20152). Suspected it is same bear that broke into their shed. CO advised that trap would be removed but to call RAPP line should they have any further conflicts. CO removed trap.
