Com explained that he collected many of the Geese as instructed by COS but did not receive a call back nor did a CO attend. Sgt. Jacobi explained that he could dispose of the Geese now as they are not needed as evidence for the offence. Jacobi explained that the offence for this is littering.

At approximately 10:13hrs, Sgt. HUNTER received a call from ECC indicating that COM's s.15,s.22 had returned to the scene and are collecting the bird carcasses and would like to speak with the CO on direction to proceed.

The details of the update obtained by ECC are as follows: on the dike at the far end past the bridge going to Westam Island Offense Details: They went to the site and found at least 12 carcasses along the edge of the river. There are probably more. Says they can wait there for a CO if one will be coming. Does he leave the carcasses there or should he collect them and put them in his truck.

Sgt. HUNTER was transferred to COM by ECC and informed the COM's that they can discard the carcasses and the investigating officer can obtain any photos that were obtained at the scene.

Sgt. HUNTER also reported that a case file has been made and an officer has been assigned to follow up. Sgt. HUNTER provided his desk telephone number and requested call back if no action was taken.

At approximately 09:36hrs, Sgt. HUNTER placed a call to COM s.15,s.22. Sgt. HUNTER was passed to COM s.15,s.22. provided similar details described in the report made to the ECC and some additional details of the description of sus and vehicle. Sgt. HUNTER obtained the additional details from s.15,s.22 and recorded them in his notebook. A summary of the details are as follows:

- observed the sus in a two toned pick up truck. The bottom half of truck is believed to be green and has a canopy;
 - COM seen the sus open up canopy and throw out approximately 20-30 gesse carcasses on to the beach;

- the carcasses are spreading out and washing up know along beach.

Sgt. HUNTER informed both COM's he would be assigning an officer to attend and investigate and the officer would contact them tommorow. Sgt. HUNTER also explained that since the tide may have washed the carcasses away and they had photos that there would be no requirement to collect the carcasses.

and 8:00 a.m. I watched as a truck pulled up to the dyke from which no one
got out for a while. The truck was a full size, s.22

with roof racks and a hunting blind was tied to the racks. Then the driver
backed up to a flood box area and got out of the vehicle. When the driver got
out I observed a s.22

s.22 I recognized him as Dale Vidulich. He let out two
labs one black and one yellow. He then took Canada geese from the back of
his truck and began to throw them into the river. When he was done he drove
away. s.15,s.22

s.15,s.22 RAPP referred him to Sargeant Todd Hunder and s.15,s.22 left
a voice message. Then s.15,s.22 we began to take pictures of
the geese.

Shortly thereafter, Todd Hunter returned our call and told us to pick up as
many birds as we could. He set up a file and said he would send out a
conservation officer to get information from us and retrieve the birds. s.15,s.22

We waited six days for a conservation officer to contact us but no one
contacted us. I then managed to get in touch with a contact I knew, Jack
Evans, Wildlife Biologist for Ministry of Forest, Lands and Natural Resource
Operation. He referred me to another conservation officer, Sergeant Steve
Jacobi who has been extremely helpful.

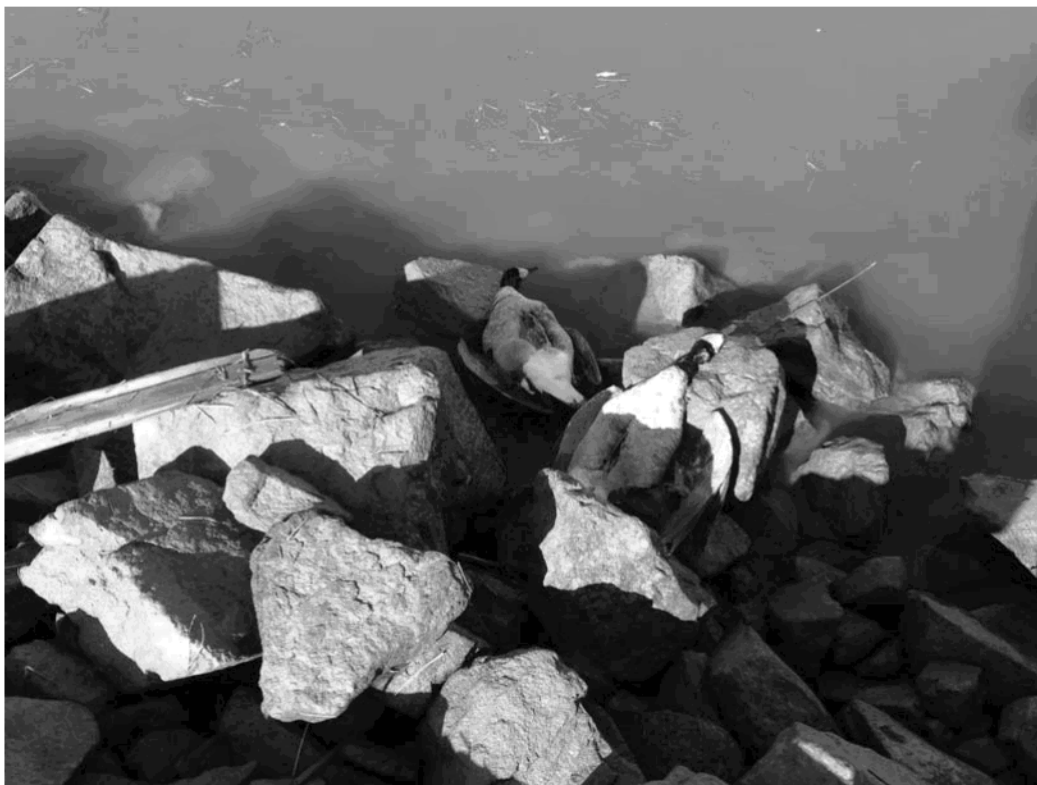
