CO DEBRUIN reviewed file and contacted Burnaby RCMP to determine last known location of bear. CO DEBRUIN contacted RCMP Cpt ROGERS who stated that bear was block away from elementary school and her officers followed bear to \$.22 S.22 CO DEBRUIN attended. \$.22 and found juvenile black bear balancing on backyard fence line. CO DEBRUIN hazed bear up nearby cedar tree. CO DEBRUIN tranquilized bear. Bear fell from tree through a shed roof and into the locked shed. CO DEBRUIN and officers waited roughly 20 minutes before investigating shed.

CO DEBRUIN opened shed door and found bear buried under broken shelving and lawn equipment. CO DEBRUIN assessed bear and found it in good health. CO DEBRUIN and officers carried bear out to culvert trap on street and met with large group of public. CO DEBRUIN allowed brief photo opportunity of bear and provided bear attractant education. CO DEBRUIN contacted SGT HUNTER regarding bear. SGT HUNTER found that bear could be linked to at least five food-conditioned black bear complaints of last two weeks. CO DEBRUIN transported bear to COS North Vancouver compound and reviewed complaints.

CO DEBRUIN reviewed complaints in Burnaby area over last two weeks and found that bear had generated roughly 9 complaints of bear in garbage. Bear was also spotted walking under busy highway and walking through a gas station. CO DEBRUIN determined that bear fit Level 2/F on the bear matrix: habituated and frequently-feeding on non-natural foods in

confined urban residential area. CO DEBRUIN determined that bear was not eligible for relocation and was to be destroyed. CO DEBRUIN destroyed bear. CO DEBRUIN emailed City of Burnaby regarding bear. 


