As discussed here are the details as I am aware regarding this issue:

s.15,s.22 contacted me regarding the possible burning of creosoted wood when the tennis court on Savary Island was torn down recently and burned. This was allegedly done by the owner of the s.22 who claimed to be an owner) and s.22 . The tennis courts and property on which they were located are located between these properties, and are owned by s.22 although I was told the responsibility for the tennis courts is with s.22 deny any creosote was even present on the site, although I think it is clear that creosoted wood is still present.

When I attended the site I was met by s.15,s.22 and s.15,s.22 (not sure of his first name). They both are area residents and witnessed the fire burning and are concerned about toxic materials burned in the fire. I noted creosoted wood pilings still in place, and remnants of burned treated wood and painted wood along with scrap metal pieces and plenty of ash. No evidence of whether any creosoted wood was burned. I took 2 photos (attached). The site is adjacent to Malaspina Promenade which runs between the properties and the foreshore, near the wharf. There are also several private wells in the vicinity.

Subject: Violation Reports – Referral to EPD or COS

In an effort to better reflect the differences in mandate and authority between the COS and Compliance, Environmental Protection Division (“EPD”), the referral process for violation reports received by the Emergency Coordination Centre (“ECC”) has recently been amended.

Most notably, a violation report (i.e., complaint) involving illegal dumping or burning will now be referred to the COS as these types of complaints usually do not involve a facility / operation authorized under the *Environmental Management Act* (“EMA”).

Note: A violation report received by the ECC is recorded in an electronic Enforcement Routing Sheet (“ERS”) and classified according to one of the following “Violation Types”:

- Dumping [COS]
- Fire Prohibition [COS]
- Fisheries [COS]
- Forest Practices [FLNRO]
- Off-Road Vehicles [COS]
- Pesticide [EPD]
- Waste [EPD]
- Water [FLNRO]
- Wildlife [COS]
- Wildlife – Invasive Species [COS]

Once classified, the ERS is then sent by email to the most appropriate NRS compliance and enforcement agency (noted above in brackets).

Referral to the COS

Dumping

A new ERS category has been created for illegal dumping. Separate from “Waste”, this new violation type includes the dumping of: construction or industrial waste, waste oil, chemicals, garbage, sewage, vehicles, batteries, or paints.

All violations classified as “Dumping” will be sent to the COS, including “in progress” and “not in progress”.

Fire Prohibition

The ERS category of “Fire Prohibition”, created last year in response to expanded CO duties under the *Wildfire Act*, has been amended to include the burning of construction waste or industrial waste in addition to campfire bans and forest fire arson.

All violations classified as "Fire Prohibition" will be sent to the COS, including "in progress" and "not in progress".

EXCEPTION - ACTION REQUIRED: If the COS is in receipt of a "Fire Prohibition" ERS that involves a facility / operation that is authorized under EMA (e.g., sawmill, landfill, etc.) officers in the zone will ensure the email is forwarded to the [EP mailbox](#) for action.

Referral to Compliance, Environmental Protection Division

Waste

With the creation of the "Dumping" violation type, and amendments to the "Fire Prohibition" violation type, most violations classified as "Waste" should now involve a [facility / operation that is authorized under EMA](#) (e.g., sewage facility, composting operations, slaughterhouse, mine, pulp mill, sawmill, landfill, etc.).

All violations classified as "Waste" will be sent to the [EP mailbox](#), including "in progress" and "not in progress".

Pesticide

All violations classified as "Pesticide" will be sent to the [EP mailbox](#), including "in progress" and "not in progress".

Incorrect Referrals

ACTION REQUIRED: If an ERS has been sent to the COS in error (i.e., incorrectly classified by the ECC), officers in the zone will ensure the email is forwarded to the [EP mailbox](#), along with a brief explanation.

EPD staff in receipt of an ERS that should have been sent to the COS will respond in a similar fashion.

Cross-Divisional Collaboration

The COS and EPD will continue to collaborate on those files which cross divisional boundaries, as per usual practice. For example, EPD staff will be involved in COS-led complaints where technical assistance and/or administrative action might be required (e.g., orders, inspections, assessments); and EPD-led complaints will be referred to the COS when an investigation or escalating enforcement action is appropriate.

Staff in both divisions are encouraged to keep the lines of communication open where the provision of advice and/or assistance would better ensure compliance with the regulatory requirements.
