0740 CO Popjes ph.d COM who stated her neighbor observed a black bear walk through her front yard and into her back yard and attack her black Labrador retriever. The attack was brief and the dog was on a long rope in back yard. Female was very shaken up by the incident and stated her dog was still trembling. Due to numerous totes also being broken and accessed by bear(s) in the area CO will set a trap today.

Further investigation required to determine which bear(s) responsible for attack of dog and breaking totes. 1700 trap set, CO spoke with several people in area that advised a scruffy, sickly bear with an ear tag was breaking totes and attacked the dog this am. Unknown which ear tagged.

2314 CO Popjes advised of a bear in trap via HWCR 17-5317. CO attended and noted an ear tagged bear in trap. No cubs noted in area. Bear was rough looking due to losing winter coat. COM stated no other bears/cubs observed. CO transported bear to Alice Lake to be dealt with in am.

2017-06-06

0841 CO Popjes advised of two orphaned cubs on 4th St. via HWCR 17-5350. CO immediately attended at Alice Lake and

noted trapped bear was ear tagged right #2529, a female. CO discussed options with Sgt Gravel. Decision made to reunite family unit on site of orphaned cubs due to no known conflict with sow. Sow released at approx. 1000 beside cubs up tree. Sow immediately ran past cubs, through back yard and tipped a tote over on 4th St. and began eating garbage. When CO's approached, sow ran off with a bag of garbage.

1335 CO POPJES returned to tree where cubs were in the am. Cubs appeared to have left. CO re-set trap for sickly bear. Sow is also a candidate for destruction after behaviour witnessed today.

2017-06-07

0740 s.22 ph.d CO Popjes direct advising the small target bear just walked past the trap and was pushing her garbage totes over. CO responded and was directed to a bear in garbage on 7th street by several residents. CO pursued a bear from 7th st. to 4th st and then back to wooded area west of 7th st. CO observed bear eating from two broken garbage totes. Bear was the sow CO POPJES and GRAVEL dealt with yesterday (no cubs present). CO did not have a safe shot on bear and was also hesitant to destroy bear as location of cubs was unknown. CO spoke with s.22 I in person who confirmed the bear she saw was a smaller left ear tagged bear and therefore not the sow the CO was pursuing. CO requested photos of target bear, none available, COM will attempt to take photos. CO unable to locate the target bear with further patrols. Many, many totes are have damaged lids which have not been replaced yet.
