2017-07-05 12:40 - AT APPROX. 0930 HRS CO HILGEMANN REC'D A PHONE CALL FROM S.22 ADVISING THAT HE S.22 OBSERVED A BB SWIMMING IN THE AREA OF COMOX MARINA. THE BEAR GROUNDED IN AREA OF COMOX LIBRARY AND APPEARED TO BE HEADED INLAND TOWARDS COMOX AVE. CO HILGEMANN 17 TO BEAUFORD AVE, COMOX

1000 HRS- ONSITE WITH RCMP MEMBER. LOCATE SUB-ADULT BB, APPROX 200 IBS, GOING FROM DUMPSTER TO DUMPSTER BEHIND BUSINESSES ALONG COMOX AVE. HEAVY PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC AND BB COMING TO WITHIN 6 FEET OF PEOPLE ALONG SIDEWALK ON COMOX AVE. MAJOR POTENTIAL FOR HUMAN/BEAR CONFLICT TO OCCUR. BB DID NOT DISPLAY ANY A/T/B DURING THE CHASE UNTIL JUST PRIOR TO TREEING WHEN IT WOOFED AT RCMP MEMBER. BB WAS INDIFFERANT TO HUMAN PRESENCE. BB HEADED NORTH/WEST INTO NEIGHBOURHOOD OF CENTENNIAL ST AND GOLF COURSE. GARBAGE DAY IN COMOX. BB WAS OBSERVED SEVERAL TIMES ACCESSING GARBAGE IN ROADSIDE BINS. ANIMAL LOCATED SEVERAL TIMES, AND APPROACHED BUT WOULD NOT TREE AND WOULD RUN OFF. BB HAD A SMALL ALTERCATION WITH A GERMAN SHEPHARD, BUT BRIEF AND W/O ANY INJURIES (AT LEAST NOT REPORTED BY DOG OWNER). DOG SCARED BB OFF. 4 RCMP CRUISERS AND STAFF ASSISTING CO HILGEMANN TO TRACK/LOCATE THE BB.

1130 HRS- BB FINALLY TREED IN BACK YARD OF RESIDENCE AT CORNER OF ANDERTON STREET AND NOEL AVE, BB APPROX. 30 METERS UP LARGE DOUGLAS FIR. BB DISPATCHED AND REMOVED.

CO PAQUIN called and spoke with COM. COM put the phone on speaker phone and stated her friend was with her. CO PAQUIN inquired who the friend was and the female stated - Heather. CO PAQUIN explained he wanted to follow up with COM and advise her that a CO was on scene with RCMP. COM sounded relieved and stated they heard a shot and hoped it was a tranquilizer gun. CO PAQUIN explained that he could not speak to what the shot heard would have been, however CO PAQUIN did explain the behaviour of the bear (habituated and food conditioned) and that unfortunately the BB would not be a candidate for relocation.

COM and her friend discussed what they could do, and CO PAQUIN explained he was unsure of if there is a program in town of comox for reducing human-wildlife conflict, so he directed COM to Town of Comox to inquire, CO PAQUIN also suggested BearSmart BC involvement.

COM asked CO PAQUIN if he had enough resources to do his job, and CO PAQUIN stated he would not discuss staffing resources with COM. COM asked if there was a CO for Comox, and CO PAQUIN explained the nearest office was Black Creek which had 4 officers that worked out of it. COM inquired into geographic area of response area, and CO PAQUIN explained NIZ geographics. COM inquired into how many officers for NIZ and CO PAQUIN explained 4 for Black Creek and 1 for Port McNeill.

COM was appreciative of call back. NFAR. Concluded.(JP)
