Narrative:

At 19:42 COS received a report of a sow and two cubs at the Whistler Fire hall, valley trail next to the Ironman event. At 19:51 a CO attended and searched area for bears. Further information revealed the bears had moved down toward Crazy Canuck Dr. CO met up with medical who advised he was told that the sow bluff charged a competitor. Incident was witnessed by a spectator who was no longer present. The incident was believed to take place on the valley trail between the fire hall and Crazy Canuck Dr.

At 19:14 COS received updated information that sow and cubs were located between the high school and the Hwy. At 19:1 CO attended and located sow and two cubs. Bears were in 30 meter wooded strip between high school where race course is located and valley trail where race course is. The CO requested that the race officials divert the race onto Hwy. 99 as the bears compromised the safety of the competitors. The CO treed the bears for tranquilization and removal from the relocation.

20:36 CO requested CO Popjes to assist.

During the tranquilization, CO had challenging circumstances with the height the cubs were up in the tree, density of branches, diminishing light and one cub becoming sedated while, still sitting on branches. CO's were able to climb the tree with use of a ladder and lower the female cub down the tree.

CO Popjes arrived and assisted in tranquilizing two COY. Last cub hung up in tree. CO Schumacher obtained ladder from muni yard. CO Popjes recovered bear from tree.

The bears were placed in bear trap from recovery. As the sow was recovering, CO's noticed that she was lying on the female cub. By the time COs were able to remove the half tranquilized sow from the cub, the female cub had died. Prior to the cub going in the trap, it was in good condition and CO's are positive that the sow suffocating the cub, was the result of its death.

Bears put in muni yard for recovery.
