The original complaint was reported by the RCMP On Aug 22nd 2018. Officers Stern and Hanratty attended location and witnessed a adolescent black bear in a tree at s.22 : trailer park. The resident at s.22 was directly below the tree (in possession of a rifle) the property owner was asked several times to go back into his home, the property owner was not listening to direction by both officers.

The residents that Stern spoke with advised that the bear had been around for weeks and getting into garbage. Stern was aware of reports of bears in the area. Stern spoke with members of the public on the property and advised them that the bear was to be destroyed and they need to leave area for their safety.

Once there was a safe situation to discharge a firearm, the bear was destroyed and loaded in patrol truck.
