The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the Department of Recreation and Conservation is desirous of obtaining the following described lands for park purposes;

Parcel C (DD 6974-N) of Section 11, Range 8, Cranberry District containing 2.36 acres more or less.

Parcel No. 1 (DD 6974-N) and Parcel No. 2 (DD 6974-N) of Section 11, Range 8, Cranberry District containing 6.2 acres more or less and 4.25 acres more or less respectively.

Parcel A (DD 6974-N) of Section 12, Range 8, Cranberry District, containing 2.51 acres more or less.

Parcel A (DD 6974-N) of Sections 12 and 13, Range 1, Cedar District, containing 4.2 acres more or less.

Parcel B (DD 6974-N) of Section 14, Range 1, Cedar District containing 1.46 acres more or less.

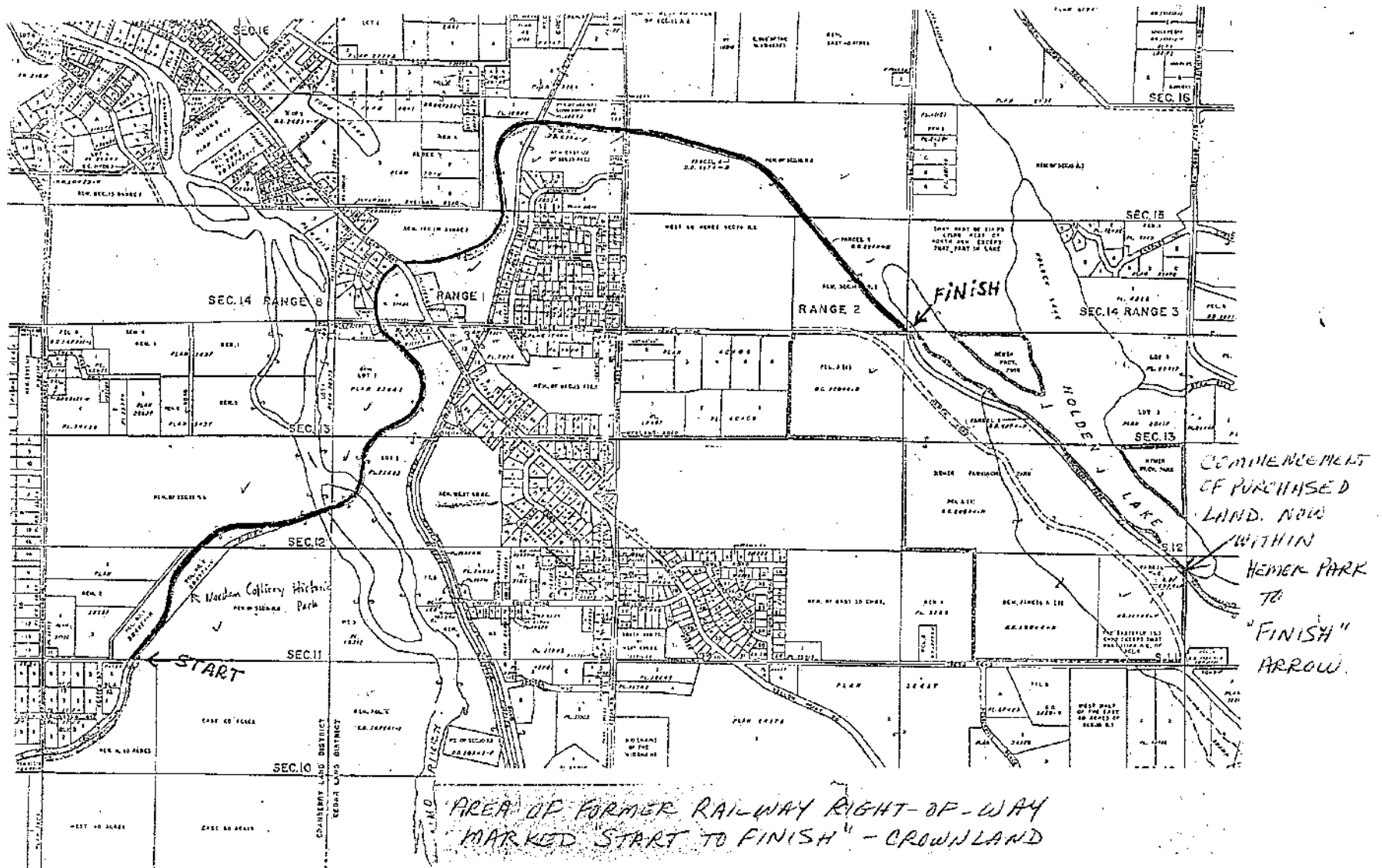

I understand that you have received an application to acquire or occupy a portion of the old railway right-of-way linking Morden Colliery Provincial Park to Hemer Provincial Park (Parcel B[DD 6974-N] of Section 14, Range 2, Cedar District).

This right-of-way was acquired for park purposes in 1971, but apparently was never gazetted or placed in any reserve status.

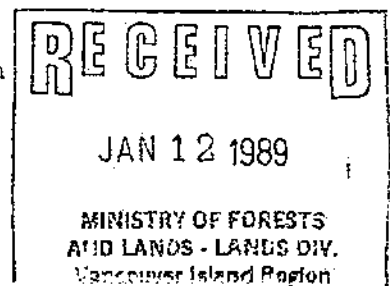
I do not believe that any of the right-of-way should be disposed of at this time. Although it may not be upgraded to provincial park status, it may have a future local use (municipal pathway/bikeway, transportation corridor). I would suggest that since it was acquired for park purposes that perhaps a reserve for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public could be placed on it.
