BC MOE Response Officer's Fuller and Meeks received information that News 1130 was reporting a spill of 1000 litres of oil near Brentwood mall in Burnaby on Lougheed highway. RO Fuller contacted city of Burnaby Environmental Services Officer Saleh Haidar, who informed RO Fuller, that the cause of spill is currently unknown, but it appears that it is coming from a vehicle that is leaking fuel. The amount according to Mr. Haidar is indicated to be well below a 100 litres.

Mr. Haidar indicated that the City of Burnaby is currently sanding and sweeping the road, to pick up any fuel that is on the road way, and they have some vac trucks standing by to clean out any catch basins that may have been impacted in the area. It was also communicated to RO Fuller that if the city of Burnaby receives any further information in regards to this incident they will provide it to MOE and PEP.
