I would like a to discuss the urgent need for increased funding for the Min. of Labour. In the Feb. 20 budget, the Ministry of Labour was allocated an additional \$1.3 million. The total budget for the Ministry of Labour for 2019 is just \$11.5million.

In 2001, the last year of the former NDP government, the Ministry of Labour budget was \$31 million. The workforce has grown by over 25% since then.

Today, Gordon Campbell imposed self-help kits are still the only way an employee who is cheated on wages (unpaid overtime, unpaid stat. holidays, unpaid vacation time...) can make a complaint. They must beg their employers to pay their wages. The Employment Standards Branch staffing was cut by 50% after the Gordon Campbell cuts. After almost a year in office the NDP's Ministry of Labour doesn't have the capacity to investigate complaints.

Vulnerable workers (non-unionized) won't risk retaliation from their employer and don't complain.

In 1998 (under the last NDP government) there were 18,000 complaints. In 2017, just 4,000. Premier Horgan mandated the Min. of Labour to stop using the self-help kits and to provide equitable investigations of complaints.

The report of the Standing Committee on Finance and Gov't Services (Nov. 2017) urged the 2018 budget to

#41 - Increase funding to the Empoyment Standards Branch to enable proactive enforcement of workplace standards and worker safety.

I would like to meet with Min. Heyman, in his capacity on Treasury Board, to support funding of at least \$10 million so that the Employment Standards Branch can begin to investigate workers' complaints about unpaid wages, as requested by Premier Horgan.

On behalf of the Labourers Local 1611 I have three short (two page) resources materials to support the urgent need for funding for the Min. of Labour.
