2019-05-31 1703 CO Klassen called COM. The garage was not breached, however, the door was damaged. COM has since put the dog food in the house. COM stated that their was a sow with two cubs. No ATB reported.

1710 CO Klassen arrived at the location and noted claw marks on the door and a big chunk removed. No ATM issues. COM stated that this bear has been hanging around for a while.

Similar occurrences have happened near this location involving a family unit. Bear causing property damage and breaking into unoccupied structures. CO Klassen set a culver trap at the end of Furry Creek Drive, past Stonegate drive.

2019-06-03 15:59 CO Popjes was advised trap doorhad been closed again. A concerned community member offered his driveway at \$.22 to set the trap, driveway covered by video surveillance. CO Popjes prepared signage to add to trap 'Tampering with a trap is a CRIMINAL offence - Violators will be prosecuted!"

TRAP will be moved to \$.22 today.

2019-06-07 11:30 SGT Gravel received call that a sow and cub were captured within the trap set at \$.22 s.22 . SGT Gravel and CO Bjarnason responded (HWCR 19-6002). One sow and cub were found inside the trap while the second cub ran behind the house. SGT Gravel used a pneudart to deliver 1cc of zoletil (vile #18-276) to the cub, first dart bounced off and fell to ground. Drugs had very little affect on the cub. 10 minutes later a second dart with 1cc was shot and hit the cub. The cub treed about 6 ft up the tree, drug took affect, and cub fell to mossy soft ground. Cub was wrapped in a blanket and was placed in pet carrier in recovery position. SGT Gravel phoned Inspector Murray Smith to discuss the outcome for the cubs.

Based on conflict history and following behaviour the sow was deemed category one and was euthanized due to public safety concerns. As per policy cubs were not candidates for care facility and were euthanized as per FLNRO policy:

-breaking into garbage totes mid-day

- -entering a permanent dwelling occupied by citizens (HWCR 19-5883)
- -unreceptive to bear bangers, air horns, and other hazing
- -comfortable in confined spaces such as sheds and kitchens
- -attempting to chew their way into garages to access dog food (property damage)

2019-06-07 13:00 Advised by concerned community member that many residents had been afraid to go outside. Advised COS that many bear bangers had been used by members of the community to scare the bears but they had no effect. Community member noted that they had little bear issues when there was no door to door garbage collection and that a central drop off would be better for the community. COS has discussed this issue with SLRD representative.

CO Popjes questioned the COM on attractants at clubhouse and was advised that the larger bear has knocked over the recycling and knocked over the grease barrel (kitchen grease) and accessed attractant. COM said the grease barrel was secured to the building and has never been knocked over and accessed in the 5 years he has worked at golf course.

CO provided advice to power wash tarmac where grease was spilled and find another method of storing attractants that is secure from wildlife, suggested to build fully enclosed structure, and wash out all recycling. COM appeared to accept advise and stated he would take steps to improve attractant management immediately.




