CO spoke to com, only fruit in yard is what is on trees. COM has 2 acres around house fenced with 7 ft high fence that bear climbs over. Last night, his s.22 dog chased the bear and com was out with flashlight, after crashing around a fruit tree the bear left. com is pretty sure the bear is a grizzly. CO asked com to call back tonight if bear returns. CO gets impression com would like bear destroyed. CO explained WLA and that a bear up a tree is not grounds to destroy. A CO to call com following day as a following up, suggested that last nights hazing by dog and flashlight may keep bear away.

2016-09-20 10:12

no update from com, info shared with bear study project leader Clayton Lamb that is looking for bears to collar.

2016-09-21

CO GORDON contacted com who advised that he shot the bear last night in his yard - its dead and has a collar. CO to attend

10:30hrs CO GORDON attended residence and com provided information as to what occurred. The bear was at the residence during the night - it approached the residence 4 times. COM's dog was outside and he was worried the bear was going to kill him. Was also concerned at how close the bear was getting to the house. COM shot the bear once with a 303 british from his window. Bear was approximately 30ft from com when shot. Bear ran a short distance and died in the field. Occurred at 02:30hrs.

CO removed radio collar, recorded information, collected hair sample and loaded bear into patrol vehicle.

**\* MONTANA RELOCATED GRIZZLY BEAR\***

11:30hrs CO contacted Montana Fish and Wildlife (number on radio collar) Spoke with Laurie Roberts, who advised that the bear was a 4 year old boar, captured in whitefish area and relocated to Frozen lake. To provide further information for collar return at a later time.

12:20hrs CO dumped carcass in remote location in sheep mtn ama area.
