I don't have any information on mortalities due to Bd, but we swabbed 31 adult Western Toads that we captured as part of our hibernation study in Duncan in fall 2015 and none tested positive for Bd (see attached). We swabbed our fall 2016 toads as well, but the samples have not been sent to the lab yet.
