On March 22, 2017, Ministry of Environment, Environmental Protection Division staff conducted an inspection of your facility, located at 48.419182 and -123.570093 degrees near 3701 Sooke Road, Victoria. The inspection determined that Tri-X Excavating Ltd./Tri-X Group is out of compliance with the *Environmental Management Act*, Part 2 Prohibitions and Authorizations, Section 6(3) waste disposal. This Warning Letter lists the compliance verification information below.

By discharging waste under Environmental Management Act without a valid authorization Tri-X Excavating Ltd./Tri-X Group commits an offence under the *Environmental Management Act (EMA)*. Section 120(3) of *EMA* states as follows:

120(3) A person who contravenes any of the following commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1 000 000 or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both: (a) section 6 (2), (3) or (4) [waste disposal];...

It should also be noted that, as an alternative to prosecution of the offence referenced above, the Ministry may initiate action to impose an administrative penalty against Tri-X Excavating Ltd./Tri-X Group. The *Administrative Penalties Regulation (EMA)* (B.C. Reg. 133/2014) (APR) was brought into force in 2014. The APR describes the prescribed provisions of the *EMA* as well as that of specified regulations under which administrative penalties can be assigned. Section 12(1) of the APR states as follows:

12(1) A person who contravenes section 6 (2), (3) or (4), 7, 8, 9 (1) or (4), 11, 25 (2), 40 (1), (2), (3), (6) or (7), 48 (8), (10) or (15), 55 (1), 72 (1) or (2) or 76.2 of the Act is liable to an administrative penalty not exceeding \$75 000.

If you fail to take the necessary actions to restore compliance, you may be subject to escalating enforcement action. This Warning Letter and the alleged violations and circumstances to which it refers, will form part of the compliance history of Tri-X Excavating Ltd./Tri-X Group and will be taken into account in the event of future violations.

Finally, I request that Tri-X Excavating Ltd./Tri-X Group immediately implement the necessary changes or modifications to correct the non-compliance(s) listed above with the *Environmental Management Act*. Further, I request that Tri-X Excavating Ltd./Tri-X Group notify this office in writing by email or letter within 30 days of this letter, advising what corrective measures have been taken, and what else is being done, to prevent similar non-compliances in the future. CO Pauwels spoke to the Metchosin Fire Chief and information was provided on the OBSCR. CO Pauwels did not attend the property with respect to that complaint. - Metchosin has fill deposit and land use bylaws in place that prohibit the importation of fill or demolition debris to the property. CO Pauwels is aware from previous conversation with Wilf Marquis, that CRD Bylaw is following up on any complaints they receive of fill or demo debris being brought onto the property. - CO Pauwels is aware that dump trucks come and go from the property regularly, but it appears that Tri-X uses the property as a base of operations and a location where trucks are parked when not in use. - CO Pauwels did his best to explain the applicability of the Environmental Management Act; specifically that the Act applies where waste is being introduced into the environment from a specific industry or activity, or where "pollution" is being caused. At this point the COS has received no evidence that "pollution" is occurring, or that waste materials are being introduced into the environment in a manner that would trigger an investiation under EMA. - CO Pauwels further explained that there is some overlap between EMA and Metchosin'

or that waste is being introduced into the environment.

- CO Pauwels expressed the opinion that at this point the concerns raised by the com relate to the use of the property for industrial / business purposes. As such, this is a land use issue, which is clearly within the mandate of the local government (Metchosin).
- CO Pauwels provided contact information for Laura Hunse, of Nanaimo EP, if the com wishes more information on EMA and what constitutes pollution, or other triggers under EMA.
- CO Pauwels also provided the FLNRO complaint # for the com to use if she becomes aware that any of the watercourses on the property are being impacted.

Com stated that her main concern was that a ravine has been filled in, and that the SOC is seeking a Temporary Use Permit from Metchosin for the property to be used for industrial purposes. CO Pauwels re-iterated that these are concerns squarely within the mandate of local government. Com expressed some dissatisfaction with Metchosin and CRD Bylaws response to the issues. CO Pauwels advised com that in his experience CRD Bylaw is very thorough and professional.

I am speaking for concerned residents of Metchosin about on-going high-volume unregulated dumping at 3659 Sooke Road, Metchosin. The District of Metchosin, in particular the CAO Lisa Urlacher, knows about the unregulated dumping of excavated material and demolition materials from other sites and, as far as we can see, is not taking action to stop what's going on. We fear for our fish-bearing creeks and our aquifer. We don't understand why there isn't a stop-work order, punitive fines, and an order for remediation

The present owner is Brian Baker of Tri-X Excavation. The previous owner was \$.22 of Aggressive Excavation, Metchosin Properties, and Mid-Island Aggregate. Land and Water BC will have a record of \$.22 and contaminated fill at Shawnigan Lake.

We believe that Capital Region District By-law Enforcement has investigation records for this property. The District contracts its bylaw enforcement to CRD.

One of our residents has photographs of trucks coming and going, which I can obtain for you.

The entrance to 3659 Sooke Road has a signs that says Keep Out Construction Site and warn of video surveillance. If you get can obtain the surveillance video, you will see the volume of dump trucks coming to the property covered, and leaving 15 minutes later uncovered. Another interesting possisbility: there is a highway traffic camera at that location. I wonder if that camera would show a record of the activity at 3659 Sooke Road.

We are concerned for environmental degradation, habitat destruction, the Bilston Creek Watershed, and aquifer 606. This property has a tributary to Martin Brook. Martin Brook, a trout-bearing stream, runs along the front of the property. Another stream from this property runs into Metchosin Creek. Martin Brook and Metchosin Creek feed into Bilston Creek. Our creek system and wetlands are home to blue-listed cutthroat trout and the red-legged frog. We have concerns for contamination of aquifer #606, which is particularly fragile.

There have been large volumes of dumping has been occurring at this site for some time, and it has been reported to the District by one of the few nearby residents. The dumping includes piles of rock and sand, which does not appear to be contained or protected with silk fencing and which have been reported to be piled near a slope. The property itself is adjacent to Bilston Creek, which has a population of cutthroat trout.

Of note is the fact that this property was previously owned bys.22 whose company Aggressive Excavating, has been implicated in the dumping that occurred at Shawnigan Lake. Dumping has continued under the new owner. The names associated with this property are Mr. Brian Baker, who I believe to be the owner, s.22 and the company operating out of the site is Tri-X Excavating.

The District of Metchosin is aware of the issues at this site; reports of dumping were presented to the Mayor and Council in December 2018 (but no serious investigation was pursued by the District). The Mayor and Council were most recently notified of unpermitted activity at the site at a Council meeting on July 29. Based on their past practices, I'm expecting no action from the District.

A look at Google Maps indicates that this property is essentially an industrial yard tucked into the trees. While the entrance is marked, there doesn't appear to be an address sign. It's located on the left hand side of Hwy 14 as you travel from Victoria to Sooke. Set your trip odometer to zero at the traffic lights by the Co-op Gas Station located on the corner of Hwy 14 and the Westshore Parkway, and the site is 2.3 kilometres ahead.
