Narrative:

2020-01-08 1916 CO PILE reviewed HWCR and called COM. COM stated BB cub is in her neighbours back yard curled up and sleeping under a patio set. COM said CUB was shivering and likely hungry. COM stated that the neighbours dogs have been barking for a couple hours. CO PILE instructed COM to remove the dogs from the porch area and allow the cub time and space to move along under its own power. CO PILE explained to COM that cubs after Aug 1 are large enough to be on their own, and COS will not take the cub to crittercare following policy and guidelines created by provincial wildlife biologist and provincial wildlife vet. CO PILE told COM to call back if the cub is still on scene tomorrow afternoon and COS will reassess.

Reviewed by Sgt. Hunter. The size and condition was not known at the time. Sgt. Hunter assigned CO Caithness and Lord to follow up in am and provided direction.

2020-01-09 09:43

CO CAITHNESS phones COM, goes straight to VM with no option to leave message because inbox is full. CO CAITHNESS coordinates with CO LORD to bring LBT and cougar live trap from GEPP to Anmore, in case assessment of cub warrants immobilization and transport. CO CAITHNESS leaves message with Provincial Vet Helen SCHWANTJE regarding next steps for cub.

2020-01-09 10:55

CO CAITHNESS arrives on site at s.22

CO CAITHNESS observes an older white male on the driveway of \$.22 with a large beige/green Tupperware tote and a bright light green blanket inside of it, in plain view on driveway. CO CAITHNESS approaches male, introduces self as CO, and inquires as to where the black bear cub is. Male states he is the

husband of the COM (name: Michael ROBSON) and that the bear cub was under the deck of his uphill neighbour at \$.22 s.22 CO CAITHNESS inquires as to what Michael meant by "was," and was informed that Michael had already transported the bear cub to Critter Care.

2020-01-09 11:45

CO CAITHNESS is contacted by Helen SCHWANTJE, updated her of the situation. She advised that given the cub is at Critter Care, ensure that it is in fact a cub of the year for 2019, get an ear tag in it, and leave it in care of CC. Advised that COS will monitor the area for calls of a sow and cub. Unable to verify if the bear cub was actually orphaned or was just venturing out of den alone or within it's family unit.

2020-01-09 13:10

CO CAITHNESS and CO LORD attend Critter Care. COS are shown a small, male, 20.6lb black bear cub. Cub is awake and alert in dog kennel. Cub is confined and then pinned by Critter Care staff so that COS can put an ear tag on him. BB tagged in right ear with yellow tag 2-430. Gail MARTIN of Critter Care insistent that COS do not chemically immobilize it because she does not want him immobilized twice (the next immobilization assuming to be done by CC's contracted vet). Due to poor health and elevated stress levels of BB, decision is made not to immobilize, so unable to examine condition of BB's teeth etc. Pictures taken of BB for use in COS investigation.
