Definitions and Interpretations

The following interpretations are provided for guidance purposes only and are not complete. For complete definitions see the Integrated Pest Management Regulation.

Pesticide uses that Require a Confirmation (refer to, Integrated Pest Management Regulation 24 (2)

Note: total land areas or numbers of poles refers to totals managed by a single entity (owner or manager).

- (a) Management of vegetation or preservation of wood on more than 20 ha a year of public or private land that is used as a railway right of way, yard or associated signal or communication facility.
- (b) Management of vegetation on more than 20 ha a year of public or private land that is used as;
 - a highway, as defined in the Transportation Act,
 - a facility or right-of-way for a public utility as defined in the Utilities Commission Act,
 - a facility or right of way for the delivery of water, not including pipes used to distribute water to consumers in a community, or
 - a pipeline, as defined in the Petroleum and Natural Gas Act, and associated facilities.
- (c) Management of mosquitoes, using bacterial pesticide, on more than 1 ha a year of public land that is a body of water.
- (d) Preservation of more than 1000 wooden poles in a year on public or private land that is used as a highway, or a facility or right of way for a public utility as defined in the *Utilities Commission Act*.
- (e) Management of forest pests on more than 20 ha a year of public land that is used for timber production or forested.
- (f) Management of vegetation on more than 20 ha a year of public land that is used as an industrial site other than an industrial site described in paragraph (a) or (b).
- (g) Management of noxious weeds or invasive plants on more than 50 ha a year of public land.
- (h) Management of mosquitoes on public land, other than with a bacterial pesticide applied to a body of water (not including aerial application to land in an urban area or used for residential purposes).

"industrial site" means an area of land on which is located industrial infrastructure and ancillary works, including, without limiting this,

- (a) facilities for manufacturing or processing,
- (b) mines, well sites, equipment yards and other facilities for or ancillary to energy production or resource extraction,
- (c) highways, transmission lines, pipelines, railways, associated rights of way and other facilities for storing or distributing products, energy or resources,
- (d) incinerators, landfills, sewage treatment plants and other facilities for the disposal or treatment of waste,
- (e) dams, dikes and reservoirs, and
- (f) facilities operated as public airports, but does not include landscaped land;

"landscape" means an area of land that has been improved by planting with ornamental plants or is maintained for ornamental purposes;

- (a) Crown land that is not private land,
- (b) bodies of water, and
- (c) land that is owned or leased for its own purposes by
 - (i) a local authority described in paragraph (a), (b), (c), (d) or (e) of the definition of that term in the Schedule to the Community Charter,
 - (ii) a university, or an institution, as defined in section I of the College and Institution Act,
 - (iii) a board, or a Francophone education authority, as defined in section 1 (1) of the School Act,
 - (iv) a regional hospital board, or a regional hospital district, as defined in section 1 of the Hospital District Act, and
 - (v) a government corporation as defined in section 1 of the Financial Administration Act

To whom it may concern,

Our current PMP, 111-0218-09/14, expires on June 4, 2014. We are hereby submitting an application for another 5-year term and a seamless transition into the new PMP. Our aim in reducing the use of herbicides where practical to do so is successful, and we have received no negative comments on the new PMP application. We work closely with our community advisory group, and keep them informed annually of our brushing and weeding plans.

The development of the new PMP was advertised in our local newspaper on January 22 and 24, 2014. In addition, letters were sent to the Sechelt Indian Band, the Sliammon First Nation, and the Regional District of Powell River for consultation. A presentation about the new proposed PMP was made to our Community Advisory Group on February 19, 2014, and no negative comments were received. Nobody from the public responded to the advertising. A summary of the consultation is enclosed.

This year's herbicide work is planned to start in July, and we will be submitting the 'Notice of Intent to Treat' shortly. For questions you can reach me at I look forward to receiving the new confirmation.



Please find attached a revised Annual Notice of Intent to Treat. Three blocks have been removed from the planned treatment for 2016: NA-912, ST-205 and FH-035. Non-herbicide treatments are now being planned for NA-912 and FH-035. ST-205 will be postponed to 2017 because of access issues. Also, PD-248 has been reduced to 3.0 ha because the number of streams in the block limits the feasibility of treatment by herbicide.

As a result of the block deletions and reductions, treatment areas in blocks TH-500, BT-664, GI-059 have been increased. Overall the 2016 program has been reduced from 93.7 ha to 90.7 ha.

The Tla'amin and Sechelt First Nations have been notified of these changes.
