Re. Immediate Stimulus Project List - Building Climate Resilience through Watershed Security Investments

1. ISSUE

This briefing note highlights the opportunity for immediate stimulus investments in projects that deliver employment opportunities to the sectors and demographic groups that have been significantly impacted by COVID-19 while at the same time increasing watershed security and strengthening our climate resilience. A detailed project listing is provided as **Appendix A** to this briefing note.

2. BACKGROUND

As governments across Canada review their options to kick-start economic recovery, they have the opportunity to make public investments that not only put people back to work, but also help to strengthen the collective capacity of communities to overcome and prosper in the face of other known near-term threats to public safety and security.

Watershed security is central to the health and well being of our communities with over **80 percent of**British Columbians asserting that ongoing access to abundant clean fresh water in their regions is
essential to health, food security, salmon, fire safety, jobs, economic well-being, and overall quality of
life, both today, and in the years to come.¹

Water and watersheds are where some of the clearest impacts of climate change are being felt by our communities/citizens, through floods, water shortages, wildfires, increased stormwater runoff, rising water temperatures and invasive species. **The 2019 Preliminary Strategic Climate Risk Assessment for British Columbia** highlighted that seasonal and long-term water shortages are some of the most significant risks facing the province from climate change.² These impacts affect human life and well-being, the safety of drinking water, food security, and critical built and natural infrastructure. impacts are also disproportionately felt by Indigenous communities, whose culture and governance systems are so dependent on healthy, thriving watersheds.

3. OVERVIEW OF PROJECTS

Over the past five weeks, Watersheds BC and the POLIS Project at the University of Victoria have undertaken a comprehensive survey of British Columbia to identify projects that would generate economic and employment opportunities while contributing to increased watershed security and climate resilience across the province. Over **120 projects** have been compiled with a funding need of over^{s.13}

a) Immediate Stimulus Projects

44 projects on this list have been identified as immediate stimulus opportunities with a funding need of s.13

A detailed listing of these projects is provided in

Appendix A, attached to this briefing note.

These projects were screened for immediate stimulus funding based on the following criteria:

- Can be started immediately
- Would generate employment quickly
- Would support employment in key demographic and economic sectors that have been most heavily impacted by COVID-19, including women, young people, indigenous peoples and other marginalized groups
- Are aligned with key government priorities, such as reconciliation, climate action, and sustainable economic development.
- Are geographically diverse and support employment across B.C. (see map)
- Build indigenous capacity & economic development

The projects are divided into 5 categories that

align with government priorities and are summarized in the table below. Notably, 20 of the projects are indigenous-led and 30 involve indigenous partnerships and would generate employment for indigenous peoples.

b) An Opportunity for Transformative Investment

The 44 projects represent a small portion of the opportunity for watershed security investment that can both strengthen community health and build climate resilience. Even the 120 projects that constitute our broader project list are just the tip of the iceberg when it comes to the potential for generating employment, economic and community benefits through investments in BC's watershed security. Through our initial assessment, we have identified high-potential strategic opportunities for coordinated, province-wide initiatives that can capitalize on this opportunity and create material long-term benefit and security for communities and all British Columbians. We would welcome an opportunity to discuss these opportunities further with the BC government.

4. ALIGNMENT WITH GOVERNMENT PRIORITIES

a) Immediate Employment Opportunities

- The 44 projects detailed in Appendix A would support the government's objectives of putting people back to work quickly and enabling unemployed or underemployed workers to find temporary or permanent employment in meaningful work with comparable pay.
- Many of the immediate projects involve restoring or enhancing natural assets, such as wetlands, riparian areas, forests and fish habitat in urban, regional and indigenous communities and territories. These are labour intensive projects that employ a range of skills. Many of the jobs generated are low-skilled in the sense that training can be provided as part of employment. These positions can support the redeployment of out-of-work British Columbians from other sectors such as retail, hospitality or the recreation and tourism sectors.
- As an example, one of the largest projects proposed, by the BC Wildlife Federation (BCWF), is a Wetland Enhancement Workforce. The vast majority of the 100 positions created through this project would be low skilled with training provided at the beginning of employment and would include tasks such as planting new plant species, removing invasive species, collecting native plants and general landscaping activities. This work is also well suited to social distancing and is targeted to areas close to communities to facilitate easy travel for unemployed retail or hospitality workers. This work is also well suited to unemployed recreation workers such as fishing or kayaking guides, and for youth employment.

Based on historical employment data, 72% of the BCWF's Wetland Program staff over the last 10 years have been women and most under the age of 30. Satisfaction from this work is high and many staff who have received training continue on to work in this sector.

Notably, as part of New Zealand's stimulus commitments, the government is investing \$433 million for improving waterways. In making this announcement, the Environment Minister noted that: "This package allows businesses considering redundancies and downscaling to

redeploy their staff on environmentally focused activities in their home region. When those businesses are able to rehire again, workers can return to their previous roles."

Economic studies have also identified that per \$1 million of investment, restoration activities create: "More than twice the number of jobs as comparable investments in coal; and more than three times the number of jobs as comparable investments in oil or natural gas."

b) Climate Mitigation & Adaptation Benefits

- Watershed security projects have multiple benefits for both climate mitigation and adaptation, directly supporting the objective of CleanBC and Climate Ready BC.
- Natural assets, such as wetlands, marshes and forests are critical carbon sinks. Improving the
 efficiency of water use in our towns, cities, businesses and farms reduces GHGs.
- On the adaptation side, these projects would support and improve community resilience to the impacts of climate change in a host of different ways, including:
 - Applying natural solutions for flood prevention that protect communities and enhances habitat for fish and wildlife.
 - Creating natural buffers to prevent polluted urban and agricultural runoff from entering waterways and impacting drinking water.
 - o Increasing community, watershed and drinking water resilience to the impact of wildfires.
 - Improving reliability of water supply for sustainable agricultural practices and enhancing food security.
 - Strengthening water monitoring capacity to better identify and characterize climate risks and impacts and support effective adaptation planning and preparedness.

c) Reconciliation & Indigenous Economic Development

- 20 of the 44 projects are indigenous-led. Many of the non-indigenous projects identified that they
 have active working relationships with local First Nations and would be seeking to employ
 indigenous community members.
- One of the primary benefits of investing in watershed security is the opportunity to advance reconciliation on the ground and support indigenous economic development. This opportunity exists in the short-term through these immediate stimulus projects but even more so as part of a longer-term transformative investment.

 Indigenous communities are leaders in this sector and watershed planning, monitoring, restoration, and stewardship offers an important opportunity to strengthen indigenous capacity and tangibly and meaningfully implement the UNDRIP and TRC principles, and BC's DRIPA.

d) Additional Benefits

- Healthy Communities British Columbians identify their connection with fresh water (rivers, lakes, and streams) as essential to their well being. Recreating in, on or close to water kayaking, fishing, swimming, tubing, hiking is part of the BC identity. Investments in watershed security make our communities more livable, improve personal and collective well being and health, and provide opportunities for people to come together as a community.
- Drinking Water Security COVID-19 has revealed a key vulnerability in our dependence on a small number of highly trained water treatment operators to ensure safe drinking water can be delivered to our homes and businesses. Investments in projects that protect water at its source are widely recognized as the first barrier in the multi-barrier approach to reducing contamination risks to safe drinking water.
- **Food Security** food and water are inextricably linked. Ensuring clean, sustainable water supplies is the primary input for local food security, whether it is salmon, cattle or crops.
- **Salmon Habitat** with the increasing pressures facing BC's iconic salmon runs, it is essential that they are given the opportunity to thrive in healthy freshwater habitats.
- Reduced infrastructure costs investing in healthy watersheds and natural assets reduces
 infrastructure costs. Whereas human built infrastructure represents a depreciating asset
 eventually requiring costly replacement, natural infrastructure is an appreciating asset, that with
 minimal maintenance produces increasing benefits at a fraction of the cost.

6. Recommendation

Investing stimulus funding in watershed security can immediately put approximately 750 unemployed or underemployed British Columbians back to work in communities across the province, not including the indirect employment and economic benefits arising from this work. This primarily outdoor work accommodates physical distancing so more people can stay employed with the appropriate safety gear and guidelines.

This strategic investment also supports many other government priorities such as climate mitigation and adaptation, reconciliation and indigenous economic development. As BC positions itself for economic recovery, this provides an opportunity to leverage existing investments and increase community security . s.13
