

2020-06-29 10:39 CO PILE brifed at time of call. CO PILE reviewed HWCR and called COM. COM stated BBs are still on scene. CO PILe instructed COM to remain inside and secure the door as best as possible. CO PILE is enroute. CO PILE advised COM to call 911 of BBs attempt to enter again.

1835 CO PILE arrived on scene Bbs still on scene. CO PILE spoke with com and shot a video of sow and 2 COY. Sow actively attempting to enter through glass sliding door. CO PILE attempted to haze off multiple times with noise. CO PILE consulted SGT Hunter and was advised to haze off with non lethal rounds. CO PILE fired one rubber slug at the sow, she then left byut returned quickly. CO PILE fired a second rubber slug and sow left area with cubs. CO PILE spoke with COM and advised to continue securing any attractants. COM advised that the sow had ripped a whole through the screen door and entered their housed and access the freezer. CO PILE asked COM to spread word around complex to neighbours about securing any and all attractants. CO PILE also advised to call RAPP for any updates including sightings, and to call 911 immediately if sow attempts to enter house again.

COS will monitor for future conflicts in the area.

2020-07-04 08:04 CO MILLER phoned COM. Bear still present, COs en route.

08:25 CO MILLER arrived on scene. Sow black bear with two COYs present just on other side of fence in greenspace. COM advised that the bear had returned after ripping through the screen door on Sunday, entering the house and accessing the fridge/freezer in the kitchen. This morning the sow ripped the screen door off the rails. Bear then stood up and grabbed the sliding glass door by the handle and the opposite edge of the door and began violently shaking it to try to open the door. COM was inside on other side of glass yelling and attempting to scare bear off. COM advised that the neighbour also had the bear chase him. Cubs appeared small, less than 20 lbs. Cubs not part of the above noted incidents. COs to euthanize sow and transfer cubs to Critter Care.

08:55 CO STARK on scene. COs discussed plan to dart sow and get cubs to go up tree.

09:09 CO MILLER fired one dart with 3cc Zoletil into sow's rump, left side. Sow took off into greenspace, cubs climbed up tree.

09:19 CO MILLER and CO STARK located sow in greenspace, sitting upright, drugs not taking full effect. SCO DAMERT on scene. DAMERT monitoring cubs in tree.

09:29 CO MILLER fired dart with 2cc Zoletil into sow's left side neck muscle. Sow ran several feet and bedded down in

09:51 CO MILLER and CO STARK still unable to move sow as she has mobility of neck and head and was responsive when touched. CO MILLER hand injected 2cc Zoletil into right neck muscle.

09:56 Sow fully immobile. CO MILLER and CO STARK loaded sow in bear blanket and began transporting bear out of greenspace.

10:20 CO PILE and 2 RCMP members on scene. Sow carried to street, secured in culvert trap.

10:51 Cubs still up tree. CO MILLER fired short-needle dart with 1cc Zoletil into first cub's rump.

10:53 Cub immobile. Female COY ear-tagged with 2-416 in right ear. Eye lubricant applied. Cub placed in cub carrier with blankets and placed in shade.

11:30 CO MILLER fired short-needle dart with 1cc Zoletil into second cub's rump.

11:34 Cub immobile. Female COY ear tagged with 2-436 in right ear. Eye lubricant applied. Cub placed in same carrier as other cub on blankets.

12:41 CO STARK delivered COYs to Critter Care. Cubs mobile.

13:00 Sow transported to wilderness area for safe location to euthanize. Bear dispatched.

14:20 CO MILLER disposed of carcass at Mission Landfill.

















