2020-07-07 16:24 CO MILLER phoned COM.s.22 advised this has been happening over the past month. Most recently Sunday. Bear has accessed food from golf bags and has been charging golfers. Bear is lanky/skinny. COM sent CO MILLER photo of bear. CO MILLER advised COM to have golfers report to COS themselves immediately after an encounter.

2020-07-08 12:00 CO MILLER attended pro shop and advised staff to put up Aggressive Bear in Area sign with RAPP line number on it and advise golfers to report aggressive behaviour to RAPP. CO MILLER asked about garbage on the course. No garbage cans on course due to Covid. Dumpster at clubhouse has metal lids and is locked.

COS will monitor future calls and respond as required.

2020-07-17 11:18 CO PILE briefed at time of update. CO PILE spoke with supervisor of golf course. BB still on scene. CO PILE attended and located BB on hole 11. CO PILE unable to confirm correct BB. CO PILE scared BB out of area and patrolled around with gold course supervisor. BB gone.

golf course supervisor to close holes 9,10, 11 for the night and place signs all over golf course, and not allow any food on course with golfers. COS will monitor for future reports

0930 CO PILE updated by golfcourse supervisor that BB on hole 9. CO PILE attended and BB GOA. CO PILE will patrol around area and respond to updates.

2020-07-18 11:33 update 4, COS has trap in area and will let it set for BB. LBT removed due to no catch

2020-07-25 14:53 update 9, CO PILE received HWCR via email while in coquitlam. Report stated that target BB was on the course, CO PILE contacted course manager and COM directly and she advised BB was now on hole 9. CO PILE attended and located BB on cart path adjacent to parkway bl. CO PILE immediately recognized BB as target BB. CO PILE approached fence separating BB and CO PILE, BB charged at CO PILE and stopped at about 2-3m due to fence, when BB turned and started to walk away BB was destroyed. CO PILE followed BB through small clump of bushes and onto the fairway of hole 9. CO PILE cleared golfers further down the hole for safety.

CO PILE contacted Course manager and asked for golfers to be diverted around hole 9 until CO PILE was able to removed BB. CO PILE was able to drive Patrol Truck onto course from parkway bl to retrieve BB. CO PILE loaded BB and disposed of BB at Mission Landfill.

CO PILE spoke with Course manager and advised to continue restricting food while on the course. manager advised they will continue to restrict food and slowly start to reintroduce late next week.
