Narrative:

2020-09-21 1419 CO PILE briefed by ECC at time of call. CO PILE reviewed HWCR and called Coquitlam RCMP for assistance. CO PILE attempted to call com but could not get through.

1445 CO PILE arrived on scene with two RCMP and advised BB was GOA. while CO PILE was providing safety information to school and community rcmp received a report of the BB down the street toward cedar elementary. CO PILE and RCMP located the BB along the walking trail and cedar park. BB charged

CO PILE had a immobilization dart prepared and attempted to immobilize the BB. the BB jumped into the creek and CO PILE waited for BB to get out of the water. once the BB left the water it immediately ran away from CO PILE and RCMP. Officers followed the BB down the trail and CO PILE flanked the trail and cut the BB off.

CO PILE was able to dart the BB with a 4cc dart. CO PILE returned to his truck to and drove back to the BB. the BB had climbed a tree and fell out while immobilized approximately 10-12 feet. CO PILE checked to see if the BB was full immobile. CO PILE and the RCMP removed BB from the bushes and place in the back of CO PILEs truck. CO PILE checked on BB and could not find any vital signs. BB was not breathing and no pulse and no eye movement. CO PILE believes that BB sustained injury while falling out of tree. CO PILE was not on scene when BB fell out of tree.

CO PILE removed BB from location and stored in Mission compound for disposal in AM.

COS has received many reports of this BB in conflict within the area where it was found.

COS is conducting an attractant audit in the area.

COS will continue to monitor for future reports in area.
