Narrative:

2020-09-30 0628 CO PILE briefed by ecc. CO PILE reviewed HWCR and immediately called com.

COM stated that there was a sow BB with two babies that were stuck in the garbage dumpster. CO PILE suited up and attended location.

when CO PILE arrived on scene he observed a Sow BB with two ear tags. CO PILE could see the bin lid start to move be not open fully. the two cubs were stuck inside the bin and the sow was pacing along the outside and on top of the enclosure. CO PILE advised A/Sgt stark that the double ear tagged BB was a target BB to be removed due to conflict over the past two summers in the westwood plateau area.

CO PILE requested assistance from CO MILLER and Coquitlam RCMP. CO PILE contacted WSO ELDER to attend with the cub carriers to transport COY to Critter Care.

Once CO MILLER and RCMP arrived officers created a game plan to immobilize the sow. CO PILE was able to dart the Sow at 0814hrs with a 3cc dart. COs watched a sow became immobile in a nearby green space. sow ran approximately 35 yards. CO MILLER topped up the sow with 2cc concentrate hand inject before removal to ensure officers safety as sow was gaining movement of her head and front legs. Officers carried Sow in BB blanket to CO MILLERs truck and loaded sow into a LBT. COs returned to the garbage enclosure and checked on the two COY inside the dumpster. CO PILE and CO MILLER mixed a jabstick with 1cc each and prepared to jabstick the two COY. CO MILLER lifted the lid slowly and used his flashlight to illuminate.

0914hrs CO PILE deployed on jabstick into the closest COY. COs closed the lid and waited for drug to take effect. 0917hrs COs opened the lid and observed one of the COY asleep. CO PILE deployed the second dose to the second COY. both deployments were to the shoulder area of the coy. COS again closed the lid to calm the COY. a few minutes later COs check on COY and they were asleep.

CO PILE entered the dumpster and passed the COY to CO MILLER and WSO ELDER. one male and one female. CO MILLER installed an ear tag into each of the COYs ears male on the left, female on the right.

COs placed COY into the metal carries on a blanket. COs loaded carriers into the back of WSO ELDERs truck and he transported to Critter Care.

CO MILLER removed the sow in the LBT and destroyed in a safe location near by. CO MILLER transferred the sow to SCO DAMERT for disposal in Mission Landfill.

CO PILE collected information from residents to contact the strata manager and company to mitigate the attractants on site. CO PILE contacted the Strata manager and set up a meeting or 0830hrs the following day (soonest appointment). CO PILE will follow up with enforcement action.

CO PILE met with Strata manager the following day and issued 2 DWPO for the property. one DWPO for the garbage spread around the area by the BBs, and one to fix the garbage enclosure to ensure this does not continue. first DWPO due date of 2020-10-02 0830hrs and the second DWPO is for 2020-10-15 at 0830hrs

CO PILE will stay in contact with strata manager to ensure DWPO is complied with.
