Vessels abandoned by owner. Dolphin was taking on water, but has reported leaking contained. Dolphin was at anchor but has dragged into deeper water, barge is tied to Dolphin with approx. 600' of 1" polyfill line tied to a tow post. CCG ER DO notified and assessing, wishes to task ALT eagle to recover vessels. Atl eagle currently enroute ETA 2300 PST. Once happy with SAR aspect, JRCC will TX eagle to ER for recovering the stricken vessels. Chartlet attached showing initial and

Coast Guard has been tracking the 50' accommodation barge that went adrift on February 18th by means of daily NASP over flights, daily NEEC track modeling's. On February 21, ROC was in communication with MSOC and was informed that the barge was spotted by the DFO surveillance plane "Speed Air" in position: 48 57.52N 126 58.53W , NASP flew over the barge @ 1300 same day, no pollution observed at the time, updated position: 48 59.70N 126 59.25W. Efforts to track the barges movements are ongoing. Today's NASP flight has been canceled due to bad weather. Standby for updates.
