Narrative:

2020-10-17 04:10 CO transferred thru to COM. COM advised bear still on site. Can hear it. It was charging house when yelled at. CO advised would attend. CO called out CO HODGSON.

Total Time Spent (hours):

2020-10-17 04:30 CO ANDERSON attended and found large sow grizzly on the road in front of the house. CO turned on red/blues lights while continuing in direction of sow. Sow quickly retreated out of sight across the road. CO hit siren tone and 3 cubs ran from yard across the road into same area as sow and out of sight. When CO truck was rolling up to the area near a trail where CO saw bears retreat the sow full charged at, and collided with the back passenger side door and step of CO truck. The sow dropped onto the side of the road in critical distress, convulsing, eyes open tongue out quivering, with noisy laboured breathing, sow unaware of CO presence. CO euthanized sow. CO spoke with COM's. COM's showed CO marks on house. Claw marks and bear smug mark was on the side of the house below window COM had yelled from. COM told CO he yelled at bear while it was standing on road and it charged at the house and he moved back from window as it hit the side of the house. That they called RAPP immediately after that. That he had seen the sow the day before in the area. CO found an . CO ANDERSON notified CO

HODGSON of occurrence and CO HODGSON diverted to office to get trapping equipment. CO ANDERSON darted 2 cubs that retreated into bushes (2 errant rounds).

2020-10-18 04:50 CO called SGT TYRE. SGT TYRE briefed on occurrence upon callback.

CO HODGSON attended and darted third cub. Two healthy fat cubs of the year recovered while still immobilized and sexed and ear tagged. Boar left yellow ear tagged 5-237, and sow right yellow ear tagged 5-246. First/largest cub darted by CO ANDERSON was not recovered. Immobilization drug and top up dart efforts failed to subdue cub to a safe handling level of immobilization. Culvert trap and 2 snares set off culvert trap near incident site. Cubs secured with trap cover and watered and fed at MOE compound. Northern Lights Society (NLS) advised 2 cubs caught and traps set for 3rd.

2020-10-17 17:40 CO ANDERSON and CO HODGSON attended in response to RAPP call of bear cub in trap and people on site. CO's attended and cleared onlookers away from trap area and did traffic control. CO's captured cub in trap at about 20:40. Cub had one dart embedded.

2020-10-17 20:54 CO ANDERSON called Provincial Wildlife Vet. Helen Schwantje and sought advise on dart removal due to immobilization drug already administered and need for further immobilization the following day by NLS. Schwantje advised leave dart in place. Secured cub at MOE office with tarp cover and watered and fed.

2020-10-18 08:24 CO ANDERSON and Schwantje discussed removal of dart. Schwantje on standby for phone advise if required. Schwantje advise very little food should be provided before further immob.

2020-10-18 08:33 CO called CO HODGSON and updated on advise provided for limited food and water.

2020-10-18 10:12 CO HODGSON updated that cubs drank water and had some apple.

2020-10-18 14:15 NLS attended MOE office. NLS immob. cub that had dart in place with jab stick. CO ANDERSON removed dart and right ear tagged 5-106 sow. Antibiotic cream put on both wounds. Boar left yellow ear tagged 5-237, and sow right yellow ear tagged 5-246 were both immobilized by NLS. Sow spontaneously aroused requiring top up and boar was very lightly immobilized requiring top up.

2020-10-18 16:05 CO updated Schwantje via text.

2020-10-18 16:40 NLS left with cubs.

2020-10-19 15:00 CO attended Nuxalk Fish/Wildlife and bear safety crew lead Jason MOODY. Attempted to provide bear conflict update. Was able to provide that sow was destroyed Friday and Saturday and attractants were unsecured garbage. MOODY advised he needed advanced notice before he could speak with CO and requested an email requesting contact. Email sent to MOODY and ELKINS (stewardship director) requesting communication opportunity.

2020-10-21 09:00 CO brought carcass to Nuxalk school cultural lead Vanessa HANS for ceremony.

2020-10-22 13:20 CO ANDERSON concluding file. No response from MOODY or ELKINS regarding request for communications to date.

Jeff and Len, I haven't sent an update note to fish/wildlife bios or Nuxalk leadership yet. Could you read to see if I missed anything important below.

Early morning yesterday there was a conflict with a sow grizzlys.22

in Bella Colla Valley.

The RAPP Line received a call for assistance for a sow grizzly and cubs charging at a house and refusing to leave. When the people tried to scare the bears away by yelling from a second storey window the sow charged at the house and refused to leave.

I attended and found a large sow grizzly on the road in front of the house. The sow quickly retreated followed by the cubs into the bushes across the road with just my trucks presence with lights and a short siren tone.

When my vehicle was rolling by the area where the sow retreated the sow full charged at, and collided with the back passenger side door and step of my truck. The sow sustained fatal injures from the collision and was euthanized on site.

I have no conflict history documented for this sow and I did not recognize her myself. Without question attractants left by people was the catalyst for this conflict and the death of the sow.

We recovered the 3 cubs by last night and they will be transferred to Northern Lights for raise and release today.
