2020-07-06 18:00 Attended COM's house. Chickens were secured in chicken house when predation occurred.s.22 Back window of coupe breeched (boarded up at time of inspection). Chicken wire fence bent down slightly into outside enclosure where window that was accessed is. Enclosure gate damaged/torn off and no longer useable. Insufficient securement of window, and doors into coupe. Chicken feed stored in coupe in plastic/rubber tote, not secured. Construction of chicken house other than the windows/doors sufficient to keep bears out. Fencing/gate into chicken enclosure not sufficient to keep bears out.

2020-07-07 15:10 CO responded to Human Wildlife Conflict Report 20-9499 of grizzly bear and two cubs caught on camera breaking into chicken coupe around midnight. CO reviewed footage. Grizzly sow and 2 coy's filmed persistency attempting to access coupe and breaking in via the window originally broken into in original breach. Also accessing over fence in the same location as original break-in.

2020-08-12 19:00 CO ANDERSON attended, met with COM. Inspected and found damage to same area of fence that sow with coy's breeched In first conflict. Also another area of fence that had new damage and fresh trail up to. Found one paw dig print near fresh trail COM showed CO at west side of property. Consistent with adult bear. Not clear enough to determine species. Set two wildlife cameras on fence one in each damage location. Provided safety advised and that e-fence would be the only way to prevent lose at the farm operation.

2020-08-13 07:22 Update 1 CO Anderson briefed by ECC and spoke with COM immediately. Sow Grizzly with 2 coy's returned twice once a 10:30pm and one more time after that. From trail on west of filed that COM showed CO. Going up to location in fence of damage of pervious night breech and of breech in first conflict with sow and two coy's. COM's scared bears off with light. COM went to bed and woke up to damaged to fence at back near wildlife camera and to the side on the chicken house and to the entrance ports. That two chickens were dead. COM informed looked like same sow and cubs that was on property before in first conflict. CO advised that e-fence will be the only way to prevent breeching in the future. CO informed would attempt capture again and would attend with culvert trap later in day.

CO HAYWARD to discuss with Sgt. Possible 2 Officer deployment.

Sgt MILLER and Sgt TYRE responded to thes.22 and based upon the sows behaviour. Sow is persistently testing the electrical fencing along with her cubs and has stepped up the damage to the facility and in particular the fencing. Bears have been accessing the fowl feed during the nights and have persistently been in the area nightly for over 3 days. The bears stay in the area throughout the night and test the perimeter and fencing to access the coup. The com has several wires of high voltage electricity protecting the entire facility but the bears continue to test nightly and when the cubs get shocked the sow goes into a rage and destroys anything in the immediate area. When the family group is confronted during the night the sow has attempted to close the distance between herself and the com in a sneaky manner by flanking and using cars and buildings to conceal her approach. The com is now afraid to try and scare the family unit off. TYRE and MILLER set to culvert traps and two snares and staked the area out in the dark for two nights. The bears did not return. Traps and snares left onsite for CONNATTY/HAYWARD to monitor.
