COM then able to scare cougar off and go their separate ways. Advised RCMP to contain cougar if located, shoot if safe shot. Briefed A/Sgt STARK. Requested houndsman.

20:05 CO MILLER on scene. Located cougar tracks in snow. Followed tracks up green space under bridge, lost tracks under bridge. Requested RCMP go to other sighting location (HWCR 20-30612). Location nearby, sighting was 10 minutes after Norm Staff Park encounter. Sighting was in direction the tracks were leading. RCMP member located tracks coming from direction of Norm Staff Park at the sighting location.

20:30 CO MILLER attended Millard Ave at Trafalgar St. Cougar tracks head into green space at children's playground. Set up FoxPro calling station using raccoon distress call. Called for 10 minutes, unsuccessful. Followed cougar tracks in snow into green space. Tracks led across Coast Meridian.

21:00 CO MILLER located cougar tracks in snow on other side of coast meridian heading in same direction. Followed tracks into green space beside Smiling Creek Elementary. Search called off for officer safety reasons. Thick forest, no longer had police backup.

Briefed A/Sgt STARK. STARK advised houndsman not available. Box trap possibly to be set in AM if safe location determined.

Summary of Incident

- A 14 year old boy walking home near the Hyde Creek area in Coquitlam reported being followed by two cougars last night.
- The COS received the RAPP line report shortly after 9 p.m. and immediately responded.
- Shortly after arrival, a juvenile cougar was located in the area and euthanized.
- Conservation Officers, using hounds, attempted to track the second cougar that was reportedly seen but were not unsuccessful.
- These cougars are believed to be linked to several dog attacks in the Coquitlam area.
- CO's are again on scene today with hounds as these efforts continue.
- We are asking everyone to report any sightings to the RAPP line.

What do you say to residents who argue the COS didn't do enough in response to these incidents?

- The COS takes every cougar conflict seriously. Public safety is always our priority.
- Enhanced resources were deployed in response to repeated cougar behaviour that appeared to be growing bolder around people and dogs.
- We also set a live trap, posted signage in the area, and worked with city partners on cougar safety outreach.
- Cougars targeting small dogs as prey is not unusual, but bold behaviour towards people in residential areas is unnatural and concerning.

Was there a dog involved? If not, wasn't an attack on someone imminent then?

- There was no dog involved in this incident.
- A cougar following a person, without a dog, in a residential area is not normal animal behaviour and is a public safety risk.
- The COS immediately responded, located and euthanized the cougar in the interest of

public safety.

Why can't you relocate the cougars?

- Any dangerous wildlife that has shown predatory or aggressive behaviour towards people is not a candidate for relocation – the risk to public safety is far too great.

Does the public still need to be concerned?

- The COS is continuing to track one cougar that was reported from last night. There may be other cougars that display concerning behaviour.
- We are asking the public to remain aware of their surroundings and keep safety tips in mind.
- Pet owners are urged to keep dogs on a leash at all times, even if it's just for a few minutes in the backyard. This simple precaution can drastically reduce the chances of a cougar conflict.
- In Coquitlam, as you know, there have been two cougar attacks on dogs, as well as one incident where a cougar charged a person with a dog. An unrelated incident took place near Buntzen Lake.
- If you live near a forested area, creek or other greenspace, it is not uncommon to see cougars.
- If a cougar shows interest or follows you, make yourself look as large as possible, make loud noise, and keep the cougar in front of you at all times. Never turn your back or run on a cougar.
