Clean Communities - Plastics Action Plan

- Municipal bylaws to ban single-use plastics the Minister has now approved nine bylaws (five in September 2020 plus four announced February 12th, 2021 2021 – Nanaimo, Surrey, Esquimalt and Rossland)
- Staff will be reaching out to UBCM in March 2021 to invite local governments for their input on the
 proposed new regulation under the *Community Charter* to allow local governments to ban certain
 single-use plastics without requiring provincial approval
- The Province has launched two StrongerBC economic recovery funding programs that may see projects awarded in your communities. Application intake closed on February 15; recipients will be announced by April
 - Recycled Plastics Manufacturing Stimulus fund to support projects in B.C. that are able to increase the use of post-consumer recycled ("PCR") plastic in the production of plastic items, focusing on innovation, supply chain resiliency and supporting the plastic circular economy
 - Clean Coast, Clean Waters Initiative fund to support marine shoreline clean-up and derelict vessel removal in coastal communities within British Columbia

EPR - Update on IP

- On September 12, 2020 the ministry announced the release of the <u>Recycling Regulation Policy Intentions</u>
 <u>Paper</u> (IP), which outlined proposed amendments to the Recycling Regulation through the priority products identified from the ministry's 2019 service gap analysis and through feedback from the CleanBC Plastics
 Action Plan consultation paper.
- The ministry received substantive feedback from key partners and stakeholders such as local governments by the November 20, 2020 submission deadline; this feedback is being summarized and will be made publicly available this spring.
- The feedback will inform the development of a five-year plan for amending the Recycling Regulation to include more products under extended producer responsibility programs.
- Amendments to the site identification process under the Environmental Management Act and Contaminated Sites Regulation came into effect on February 1, 2021 that directly affect all municipalities in BC.
- Supporting amendments were also made to the *Local Government Act, Land Title Act, Islands Trust Act* and Vancouver Charter to reflect these changes.
- This process ensures potentially contaminated industrial and commercial properties are investigated and remediated following site closure and prior to redevelopment.
- Municipalities can no longer opt out of site identification administration; 43 municipalities had
 previously opted out under the former process. To facilitate a smooth transition the ministry has
 reached out to all of these municipalities to provide support on implementing the updated
 requirements in their municipal processes.
- A new site disclosure statement replaces the former site profile form, which must be submitted for industrial or commercial properties upon application for subdivision, zoning, development or building permits that likely involve soil disturbance. Municipalities continue to have 15 days to assess and forward the form to the site registrar.
- Submission of the site disclosure statement form triggers requirements for site investigation and reporting and prevents the municipality from approving the triggering application until specific requirements set out in the municipal statutes mentioned above are met.
- New web pages have been created to help applicants and municipalities understand the site identification process and to fulfill their respective duties.

While we will continue to work with the FNLC Working Group on CPAS-related matters as a key engagement opportunity, this may not be sufficient.

We will likely have to keep open the possible need to engage with other Ingenious representatives (including current members of the ICAT WG) to take advantage of their interest and expertise in climate adaptation-related matters. The feedback we received is that the FNLC does not represent the variety, depth and breadth of Indigenous communities across BC, nor do they have the "onthe-ground" experience developing or leading climate adaption initiatives. I am also a bit concerned about being too closely tied to their priorities and timelines as we may have to move "fast" on the climate adaptation file and this may not work within their plans.

Hi Jeremy,

Tina and I had a productive call with Paul Squires this morning, which included Tina walking him through a presentation on the CPAS. Overall, we were more than pleased how supportive he seemed to be regarding the CPAS and has offered to meet with us on a regular basis moving forward. He also kindly offered to review and provide comments on the draft CPAS (which is wonderful).

Here is a brief summary of some of the key points. I have highlighted those that may be of particular interest to you. I have cc'd Neil as well as he too may be interested in this intel.

Economic Plan 2.0

- Expecting a significant public release in fall 2021
- Theme likely to be "innovative, sustainable, inclusive"
- ADMCE to discuss in coming weeks
- If it has "shades of Stronger BC" could have dollars attached
- Good alignment with adaptation strategy, building on Stronger BC opportunity to align CPAS actions/funding
- Paul supported CAS connecting with the shop responsible for new economic plan (JERI) to explore potential linkages to the CPAS. This raises a broader issue of how other aspects of CleanBC will be/should be considered in the development of the Economic Plan

DMCE March 19 - Bobbi Plecas has commented that items coming to DMCE should go through ADMCE first. I do not believe that this is currently being contemplated. May need a rationalization why items are not being feted through the ADM committee.

Planning & Priorities Committee

- Paul noted that his shop is planning all P&P meetings for coming year as well as the whole mandate
- He agreed with and supported our plan to seek Cabinet policy direction on CPAS 2022-25 in the fall. He will consider the need for a CPAS Cabinet decision in the fall during the planning of Cabinet committees currently taking place, and to what extent, if any, it

- should be bundled with other CleanBC initiatives such as Roadmap to 2030, or if it should considered more of a stand-alone topic
- Significant that 4/5 Clean BC initiatives are going to P&P in a short window more than any other program area
- Likely to get policy support on CPAS; Hard part likely to be TB (i.e., \$)
- Re. business case Other areas of gov have similar challenges demonstrating return on investment. E.g., childcare made links between investing in childcare and benefits to the economy by having more parents employed. Gov does not have a consistent approach on evaluating this kind of investment.
