# Bert Flinn Park



Bert Flinn Park was dedicated as a result of a referendum in 1999. Largely undeveloped, the park has an extensive trail system for hikers and mountain bikers. The park is home to many bird and animal species including bear, raccoon, coyote and barred owl. Wetlands located at the north end of the park along the gasoline right-of-way are home to many pond creatures including red-legged frogs and Northwestern Salamander.

- Most trails are unmarked; use caution when traveling on unfamiliar trails
- No motorized vehicles allowed on trails.
- Stay on designated trails.
- Trails and boardwalks may be wet and slippery. Please use with caution.
- Trees or branches may fall onto trails. Do not enter during high winds.
- Watch your step; trail surfaces are uneven and include roots and rocks.
- Wildlife (bears, cougars, bobcats, lynx) are present in area. Please be aware of your surroundings.
- Do not feed wildlife.

Park Size: 126 hectares

Trail difficulty: Easy

**Note:** dog off-leash walk is located on the gravel right-of-way west of the Heritage Mountain Blvd / David Ave roundabout.

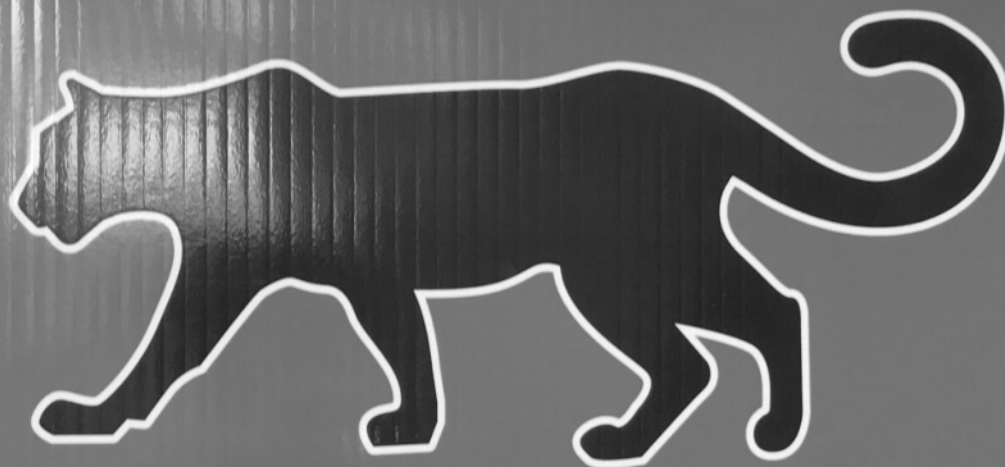
