Narrative:

2021-04-23 15:50 CO MILLER attended, large adult bear laying down in small greenspace on other side of wire fence behind row of townhomes. On one side of the narrow green space was townhomes, other side was busy 4 lane road. Bear has been in same spot since 06:00. Bear appeared to be in some sort of distress. Did not want to move very far. CO MILLER assessed bear's mobility when it moved about ten feet then laid down again. No injuries apparent, mobility ok. CO MILLER discussed with Sgt HUNTER. Called in CO STARK and two RCMP members to assist.

18:00 CO STARK on scene. Bear still in same spot. COs to immobilize and assess.

18:17 CO MILLER fired dart with 3ccs Zoletil, vial 20-140, into bear's rear right thigh muscle.

18:27 Bear laying down with head down. CO MILLER made noise to check bear's mobility, bear lifted head.

18:34 CO MILLER approached bear and checked sex, large adult male. COs attempted to roll bear onto bear blanket, bear reacted and still had mobility of head.

18:46 CO MILLER hand injected 1cc Zoletil, vial 20-145, into bear's right side neck muscle.

18:50 Bear under full induction. CO MILLER assessed bear, no injuries observed. Teeth have some wear.

19:00 COs and RCMP transported bear carefully on bear blanket and loaded into culvert trap. Ear tag 2-471 attached to left ear.

19:10 CO MILLER made several attempts to phone wildlife veterinarian, unable to contact. Discussed with Sgt HUNTER. No conflict history. Decent body condition, no garbage in scat. Decision made to relocate bear.

19:45 CO MILLER and CO STARK transported bear to 21.5 km mark of Coquitlam Lake Watershed mainline next to water source and food sources (skunk cabbage, grass).

21:15 Bear released. No apparent injuries.

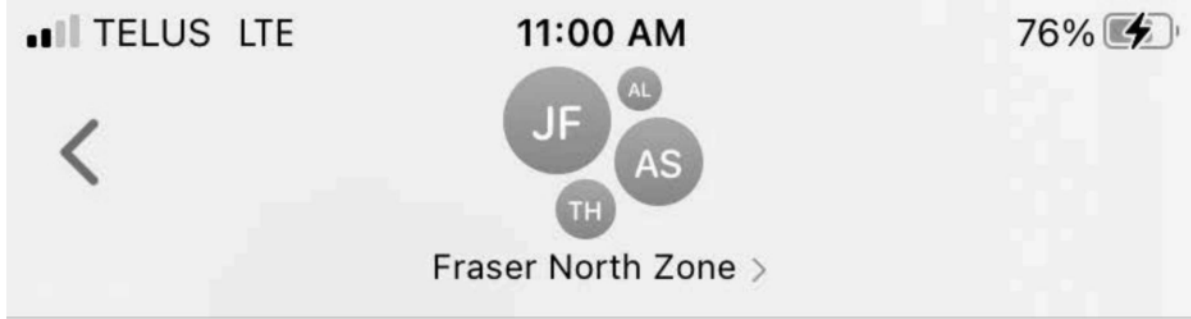

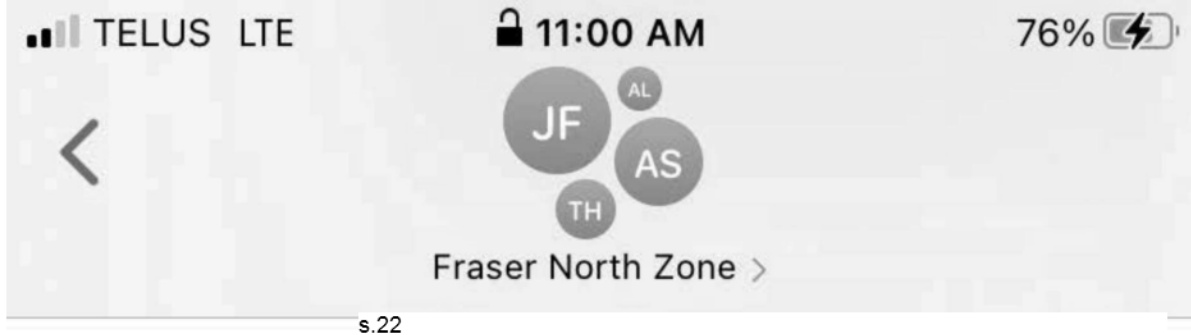

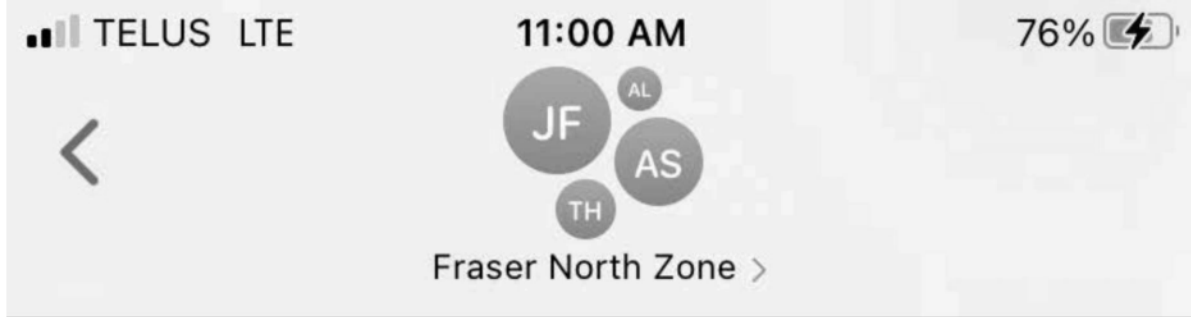
