-Why is this area still closed? (since Nov. 15)

Smugglers Cove was closed due to extensive flooding. It has remained closed because sections of the trail are still submerged.

-What needs to be done for it to reopen?

The water has been receding steadily and we expect the trail to be open by the end of the week, but this is subject to weather.

-How much will this cost?

It's too early to say. We are still gathering information regarding the extent of the damage. We'll have a better idea of how long the work will take after we gain a more fulsome understanding of the work required.

-What is the timeline for reopening?
