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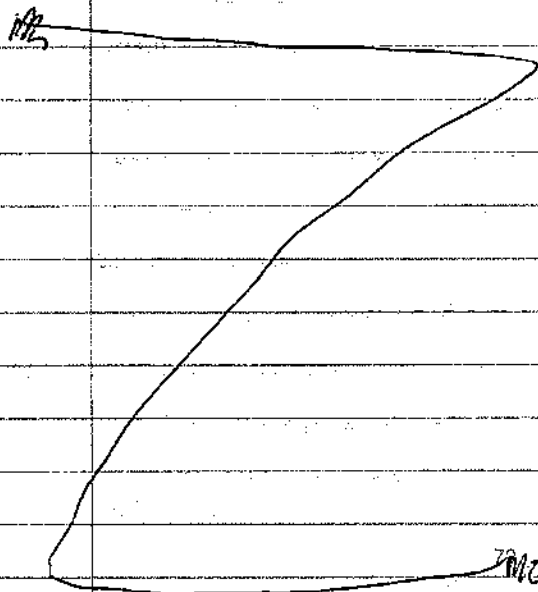

away on the sound of ⁹⁴
the dart gun. 1 Bear went

up a tree, the other ran
into a bush and disappeared.
Sterling watched darted
bear enter an old shed.

I watched bear climb a
tree, while ^{s.22}

kept cub up a tree.
Riddell attended ^{s.22}

^{s.22} who were outside
and explained the situation.
They understood as they
said the bears have been
a huge issue this year
and it was because of
the ^{s.22} ⁹⁵

^{s.22} Riddell was



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alerted that the bear which entered the bush was back at the ^{s.22} house on the property. Riddell found the bear in the carport. Riddell walked within 10 meters of the bear without it scaring off. Riddell then had the dart gun, and darted this bear. This bear then slowly walked behind another shed and crawled underneath. By this time the first bear Sterling darted was ⁹⁶ asleep, and Sterling went to keep ~~adult~~ ^{s.22} bear up the tree, while I asked to keep cub up the tree and the others from a safe distance to let Riddell know where the bear he darted goes, if it moved. Riddell then called Co Eichstaetter to attend. Riddell then dispatched first tranquilized bear in the shed, due to low light and tires/bullets 3 shots were fired by pistol. Riddell then ⁹⁷ returned to other bear



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tranquilized and euthanized
as well, 1 shot gun and 1
pistol shot. Riddell walked
onto driveway and the

outside upset and admitted
to Riddell freely that
