CO Smienk attended and met with cn. Second time bear has caused damage to secure shed. First time not reported to COS and cn fixed damaged door with sheet metal door over solid wood.

Second time bear caused damage to shed it went through side wall of building. Solid wood wall with tar paper vapor barrier. Shed stores garden tools and gardening supplies. Small garbage bin in shed that has no scented garbage. Cn does not compost or throw away food waste, as they use an in house composter.
