Narrative

2022-07-19 1209 HARBICH was briefed by ECC that there is a bear inside a house with the occupants of the house barricaded inside (HWCR 22-019880). RCMP dispatch advised that WVPD are on scene and the bear is outside on the driveway eating food from the kitchen. Occupants still inside.

1228 HARBICH arrived on scene and found a large black untagged BB eating food from the kitchen in the driveway. BB tore open the front kitchen window, climbed into the kitchen, grabbed some food from the freezer, and took it to the driveway to eat it. HARBICH had used all his **s.15** and no officers nearby to bring any. BB was observed going back and forth from the driveway and then climbing back inside the house to get more food several times. WVPD were able to call the occupants inside and found a safe route to get them out of the house. Residential area, no safe location to take lethal action against the bear with a firearm where the bear was situated

1250 BB went back inside the house. HARBICH went to the side of the house with cans of sardines to make a scent trail leading to the back yard of the house in hopes of luring the bear to the back yard so that HARBICH could walk through the house and onto the deck where there is a safe backdrop (shooting downhill into the earth). While HARBICH was making the scent trail, the bear began coming out of the house. A WVPD member with less-than-lethal shotgun rounds deployed two shots that hit the bear in an attempt to keep the bear inside the house while HARBICH went to a safer location, but the bean bags had no effect and the bear ran towards the backyard and down the ravine. HARBICH could hear the bear going down the ravine towards the creek. HARBICH and WVPD members tracked the bear in the creek

1305 BB located walking in the creek about 60yards away from HARBICH who was standing on a backyard staircase looking downwards at the bear with a WVPD with c8 as backup. HARBICH scanned the area and found no people/buildings behind or between the bear. HARBICH discharged one shot from the patrol rifle and the bear dropped where it was standing. No signs of life, bear was believed to be dead.

1312 HARBICH walked down to the creek and confirmed the bear is dead.

BB displayed category 1 behaviours as described by the HWCR guidelines and was killed in accordance with said guidelines. HARBICH and an attending WVPD member identified this bear as the same bear that entered a garage and accessed garbage 6 days ago (HWCR 22-018507). **s.15**

The bear seemed unbothered by the caller. The bear then wandered over to the garbage hut and started eating the garbage before the caller's roommate scared it away. Caller is sure the bear will be back momentarily if it's not already. Incident occurred about 10 minutes ago.
