It came to our attention that the woodlot Licence 2031, came up for renewal, July 21 2021. It was in fact renewed in November 2021. We are not aware of any such notice being made in the local paper: Campbell River Mirror / Discovery Islander or the Hungry Eye!

In contacting the C&E office, Campbell River, the staff person was not able to locate the file: electronically or in paper form. We request your influence at providing us with a copy of the approved Woodlot Licence.
