2020-09-10 1600 Gravel briefed by Popjes. Gravel responded. Found mature Grizzly bear eating apples in the front of house about s.22. Gravel requested RCMP back up and ask CO Popjes and Mueller to attend the location. Gravel hazed the bear towards the river using rubber slug. Bear was not intimidated by human presence, loud noise and voice. 1700 Popjes brought a trap at the location and was set in the

backyard. 1730 Gravel discuss with resident that is s.22 very attached to the tree. Gravel explained that the bear will likely be back and efforts need to be made to remove all apple from the property. resident agreed and will coordinate apple removal for the next day. 1800 Officer Mueller arrived on scene and was briefed. Mueller stayed on scene to secure the area until dark and monitoring trap. 2000 Mueller confirmed Grizzly bear was trapped. Gravel attended and assisted Mueller with trap removal and bio Metric collection. young adult male, Approx. 375lbs. 2200 Bear left @ Alice Lake office for recovery. 2020-09-11 0830 Gravel Discussed with Senior Biologist Nicola Bickerton to determine suitable release location. 08:45 CO Harbich and Mueller travel to Squamish Valley with GB for release. 2020-09-27 1830 Popjes was briefed about GB back in residential area. Popjes confirmed and requested help from Gravel. Gravel attended and s.15 Bear walked away but Popjes was able to track him and access him when he was down. Bear was in a creek and difficult to remove from the area. 5 RCMP members attended for transferred into a bear trap. The bear was healthy, male between 25 and 30 years old. Popjes and Gravel discussed with Wildlife biologist Steve Rochetta and decided to release bear in Squamish Valley the next day. Decision was based on level of conflict, health of the bear and capacity to contribute to recovery efforts in the local population. Popjes released

bear the next day.
