Hello Tom,

Thank you for your email. I have reviewed our electronic files for this site and we have no reports listed. You could try contacting AMEC, the consultants who prepared the report in 2003. Our notes do indicate that remedial excavations took place at the site in 1993, with transfer of contaminated materials to a landfill at that time. Without a legal instrument under the Contaminated Sites Regulation (e.g. a Certificate of Compliance or a Determination of no Contamination) or another Administrative Guidance 6 (AG6) release, future authorizations for redevelopment of the site would be suspended under section 557 of the *Local Government Act*. The subdivision permit was released as a Scenario 2 under AG6; however, the outstanding investigation has only been delayed until a future application (e.g. development permit) is submitted, retriggering the process.

Thank you for your email. The outstanding requirement that was outlined in the original 2004 letter is described in the succeeding paragraphs of the October 9, 2019 letter.
