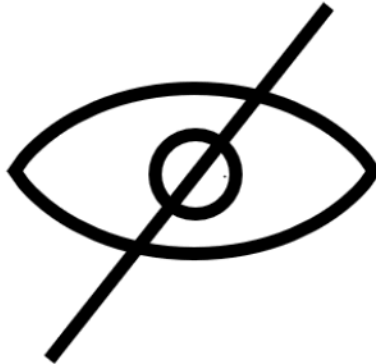

COM advised she was attacked by a black bear while hiking. She was up on Coho Trails, crossing over the second trestle bridge, and spotted a black bear at the other end. She turned back and began running. Upon doing so, the bear gave chase. She jumped down under the bridge with the bear following. She ended up backed against a rock wall, picked up a 4x4, and began swinging it at the bear. The bear swiped her leg causing minor scratches. The whole incident lasted 20-minutes. She noted tripping in a hole caused more injury than the bear. A passerby cyclist was able to scare the bear off. The bear began to follow both of them before giving up.

2023-04-22 1530: CO ZUKEWICH attended callout, observed a bear laying in a wooded plot between the top of day lot 2 and Sundial place, not moving. Bear appeared to be extremely lethargic and unable to move. CO noted a green ear tag in the bear's ear and called Sgt/CO for advice. Sgt/CO advised the bear had a high conflict history. CO ZUKEWICH also noted that the bear had been bluff charging RMOW workers who had attempted to shoo it away, and had even bitten a bucket held by one of the workers. One worker stated to CO that the bear had attempted to tree prior to CO arrival, but did not have the strength and laid down to rest. CO requested RCMP attendance for crowd control, once a safe shooting lane was cleared, CO destroyed bear. Bear was a sow, teeth in very poor condition, stemming from old age, most incisors missing, greyed out fur on face, 60lbs in weight, CO was able to lift the animal with one arm. Ear tag #745 tagged in 2008, 5+ years old at time of tagging, bear likely over 20 years old.	Zukewich, Sasha			
2023-05-27 1730 CO attended campground at BC Parks request to support trap set for persistent small male (175-200lbs) BB with white chest patch. CO met with COM, s.22 COM described 2 BB, one larger black boar, one smaller BB with chest patch, chest patch BB described by COM as bluff charging and hesitant to leave when hazed by noise.				
1845 White chest patch BB approached CO and campers, resistant to audible hazing, but eventually left. CO received comms from BC Parks staff of BB location, headed back toward campsites, CO hazed with chalk balls. BC Parks Staff set trap at group sites.				
1900-2115 CO informed of BB accessing food at day use area, CO arrived to campers stating bear had pushed them off of their food, CO approached area to discover a larger (250-300lbs) all black boar eating camper's food on picnic table. CO deployed chalk balls and treed BB. BB came down from tree and fled from CO sightlines, CO disengaged and met with BC Parks Staff and RCMP. CO hazed smaller chest patch BB 3x, final time leading to smaller BB catch at group sites trap, catch time approx 2116. Simultaneously, Park Operator treed larger BB 2x before catch in second trap set at day use area at 2200, BB catch at 2345.

2023-06-28 15:31 CO Schumacher contacted COM. Approx. 3 or 4 weeks ago, they called RAPP line (see HWCRCR #23-018881). COM not on site but has workers on site building a deck. Workers previously fixed shed after it was broken into the first time. Bear attempted to break into garage, and caused damage after garbage was moved in there. Workers went to put a rake back in the garage today and observed a small bear in the shed. Bear had ripped into shed and gained access again. CO advised that he would attend to get the information from the workers on site.

CO jabbed sticked bear with one vial without it getting up. CO jabbed sticked the bear a second time with second vial. Bear did not get up and only 1cc was administered. CO jabbed attempted to jab bear again but it moved off into neighbours yard. Bear not weight bearing on hind leg. CO followed bear into neighbours yard and jabbed it with remainder of vial two, while it was climbing a wooden fence. Bear fell off wooden fence within about 3 min. 2023-08-02 1415 CO ZUKEWICH briefed by CO SCHUMACHER of bear in house, with RCMP attending. CO ZUKEWICH began travel from Retta Lake to attend. At approx 1435 CO ZUKEWICH was informed BB was GOA by RCMP via radio.				
UPDATE 2: 2150 CO ZUKEWICH briefed by CO SCHUMACHER that BB had returned and entered house, currently on site, came in as 911 call to RCMP, CO ZUKEWICH en route, lights and sirens activated.

2023-08-09 1500 - WSRO ROCHON visited campground and spoke with guests as well as owner/COM. Guests state a small BB has been going from site to site for the last three days and has pushed a campsite off a picnic table with food and stole food. COM states that they sometimes use bear bangers with little affect. ROCHON saw a terrible "food locker" that was in no way bear resistant. ROCHON advised COM to replace food locker storage and to make sure to control attractants and pass message to campers. ROCHON provided bearsmart advice and to call RAPP line upon any unusual or unsafe bear behavior. ROCHON posted a COS bear alert sign. Will monitor.

1228 HARBICH arrived on scene and found a large black untagged BB eating food from the kitchen in the driveway. BB tore open the front kitchen window, climbed into the kitchen, grabbed some food from the freezer, and took it to the driveway to eat it. HARBICH had used all his **_____** and no officers nearby to bring any. BB was observed going back and forth from the driveway and then climbing back inside the house to get more food several times. WVPD were able to call the occupants inside and found a safe route to get them out of the house. Residential area, no safe location to take lethal action against the bear with a firearm where the bear was situated

1250 BB went back inside the house. HARBICH went to the side of the house with cans of sardines to make a scent trail leading to the back yard of the house in hopes of luring the bear to the back yard so that HARBICH could walk through the house and onto the deck where there is a safe backdrop (shooting downhill into the earth). While HARBICH was making the scent trail, the bear began coming out of the house. A WVPD member with less-than-lethal shotgun rounds deployed two shots that hit the bear in an attempt to keep the bear inside the house while HARBICH went to a safer location, but the bean bags had no effect and the bear ran towards the backyard and down the ravine. HARBICH could hear the bear going down the ravine towards the creek. HARBICH and WVPD members tracked the bear in the creek

1305 BB located walking in the creek about 60yards away from HARBICH who was standing on a backyard staircase looking downwards at the bear with a WVPD with c8 as backup. HARBICH scanned the area and found no people/buildings behind or between the bear. HARBICH discharged one shot from the patrol rifle and the bear dropped where it was standing. No signs of life, bear was believed to be dead.

1312 HARBICH walked down to the creek and confirmed the bear is dead.

BB displayed category 1 behaviours as described by the HWCR guidelines and was killed in accordance with said guidelines.
