

14	Caller is reporting he found a dog in a snare at the noted location. He released the dog but is concerned about how close the snare is to the road. <20 yards from the roadway. Caller wrapped the snare around the barbed wire fence nearby
	<div>My dog was missing for 24 hours and when I found her she was caught in a wire snare in the woods s. 22 The place I found her is roughly s. 22 in a straight line on a map. The snare was the type that doesn't slacken off when the animal stops pulling, just gets tighter and tighter and stays tight. I don't know if the trap was old or currently in use but the location of it makes me find it hard to believe she just randomly wandered into it without it having been baited. I noticed no trigger mechanism and did not look for one as I was more concerned about getting my dog's leg out of the snare. I took some pictures but left the trap where it was after cutting the wire to free my dog. s. 22 The trap was roughly s. 22</div> <div>The woods in the area have several trails that people and their dogs frequently use and many trails lead into the local residents back yards. The trap was 50-70m off of the closest trail. I don't know if trapping in this area is illegal or the style of trap is illegal or if my dog just got unlucky, but I figured I would report it anyway.</div>

16	Caller's s. 22 s. 22 has been doing some things that scare her and it has been going on for years but this is new behaviour. He has inhumane traps in the ditch and sloped grass in front of his property s. 22 and has erected some kind of fencing to trap animals, both domestic and wild. He also has pit traps in his back yard. He has already trapped s. 22 cat. SPCA said they have no jurisdiction in this area. s. 22 RCMP Cst Waterton insisted caller report to RAPP.
17	Caller advises of a neighbour that leaves out food and compost to feed the deer in the neighbourhood but in doing so are attracting skunks. The neighbours have a live trap that they've used for years to trap the skunks and transport them out of the area. The trap caught s. 22 cat last week as it was placed in the alleyway s. 22 neighbours who stated it was their trap and they do not have a permit for it even though they're in the city. Caller is requesting a call back.

They both consumed rodenticide. The operation manager called their pest control company, who said that there was no worry as the traps were empty and shouldn't have been there. We rushed our dogs to the veterinary clinic and they induced vomiting under direction from poison control. Both dogs were confirmed poisoned. 25	COM reporting his dog was walking offleash beside a popular walking trail when it came running back to the COM yelping with a bloody tail. The COM took the dog to the vet this morning and found the tip of the tail had been cut off cleanly. COM suspects the cut may have been from an illegal trap in the area.
26	Caller reporting a potential shooting of a bear yesterday late afternoon. Caller did not see it but heard about it second hand. There was a bear being chased by dogs in front of the noted location below and they heard someone yell "shoot it" and heard a gun shot right after. Caller does not know if the bear was injured or still alive. Caller advised that the suspect spilt prawn bait all on his front walk and has not cleaned it up. Caller also advised that the yard always smells like fish and that the suspect has live traps and leg-hole traps set up in his yard. A neighbour once found her cat in a live trap while the suspect was away on holiday. Caller is very concerned.
27	Caller reported that their dogs were caught up in traps on Crown Land about a week and a half ago. Last night the caller checked the traps and there was a dozen traps still setup. Caller left a voice mail and email the local trapper's association. In the location, there are still animal carcasses. Caller believes the traps should have been removed because trapping season dates are over.
28	Advised that yesterday afternoon around 1230pm, while driving from Whitehorse, caller stopped at the below noted location to let dogs out to stretch etc.... One of his dogs became caught in a neck snare trap. Caller was able to free his dog (who was injured but expected to survive). Caller states that there was a dead wolf carcass next to the trap. He was able to render the trap in operatable. Caller has photos and can be reached with direction on where to forward them to.
29	Advises that someone has set up beaver traps and the COM s. 22 was walking her puppy and it got caught in one of the traps. RCMP file #: 23-4448
30	s. 22 individual doing the trapping to advise that she was trapping raccoons and humanely killing them. She had also caught several cats and wanted the people in the area to be advised and to keep their cats inside while she was doing the trapping.
31	Caller reporting a cat that was caught in a snare yesterday. (neighbour's cat) The cat survived and showed up at it's residence with the snare on it. The caller indicated her cat was found in a snare that had been placed by a neighbour a year ago. The caller's cat was found and released by the caller. The caller suspects the same person is continuing to set snares to harm domestic animals.  The caller was referred to COS by the RCMP. Caller referred to BC SPCA, RDN Bylaw.

She got a message from another local saying that she had another person report that the same happened. She suspects it is her neighborhood. She still has the snare and lots of photos. 33	s. 22 dog looks to have been killed by a snare trap, the dog was found on a farmers field, the snare was not present. This is the second dog in the area to have been caught in a snare trap, caller reports a friend found their dog in a trap and was able to free them. The traps are on a s. 22 property and are being used to catch coyotes. Caller believes that the s. 22 caught his dog in the snare trap and then dumped the body on the farmers property. Caller is requesting a CO call back.
34	Reporting someone is using animal traps illegally. Friday at 16:00 callers friend was walking the trail with a dog and the dog was caught in a trap, it was around his neck. The dog is now going to be going in for surgery, the teeth were destroyed. Trap was laid by a man who has chickens and was trying to catch a bobcat. The trap was baited with salmon.
