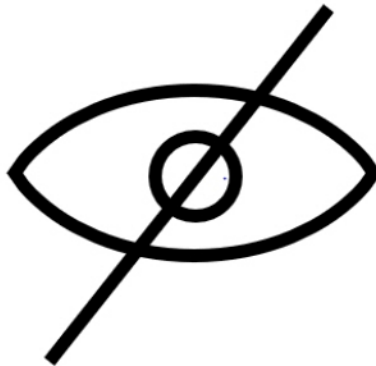

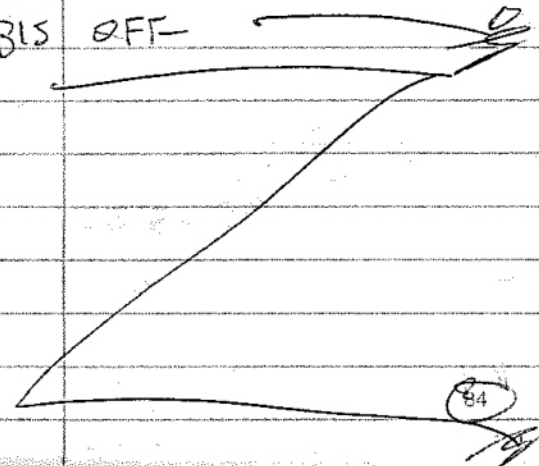

Caller is with By Laws, Adult male with yellow tag in left ear. Poss 300 - 400 lb.
He had responded with several other workers and were able to finally get the animal out of the house, it appears to have entered through an open door in the back. His biggest concern was that the bear was very chill and not showing any fear and after it got to the end of the driveway out front and he was trying to get it to carry on, at one point it looked like it was going to turnaround and come towards him. It probably didn't help that dogs at various neighbours nearby were barking like crazy as well.

Narrative

2023-08-02 1415 CO ZUKEWICH briefed by CO SCHUMACHER of bear in house, with RCMP attending. CO ZUKEWICH began travel from Retta Lake to attend. At approx 1435 CO ZUKEWICH was informed BB was GOA by RCMP via radio.

UPDATE 2:

2150 CO ZUKEWICH briefed by CO SCHUMACHER that BB had returned and entered house

currently on site, came in as 911 call to RCMP, CO ZUKEWICH en route, lights and sirens activated.

2220 CO on site with 2 RCMP constables, bear in house actively feeding on garbage, CO and Constables attempted to intimidate bear from one open door while leaving path through rear door for bear to exit. CO observed what appeared to be signs of forced entry (gap in door frame) Bear continued to eat, and exited after feeding. CO followed bear into road and shot 5 times at bear, CO observed that bear was hit. Bear headed into dense brush and CO heard bear bed down. CO elected to disengage for officer safety due to dense woods and poor visibility in darkness. CO took photo and video of house bear was inside and observed damage to door bear was believed to have entered. CO ZUKEWICH plan to attend early tomorrow to attempt to locate bear. Large ear tagged male (left ear), BB is known to COS and is a category 1 bear.

2023-08-03 0630 CO ZUKEWICH attend site to attempt to locate bear.

0730 BB located deceased and retrieved. Details in outcome. Returned to forest for disposal.
