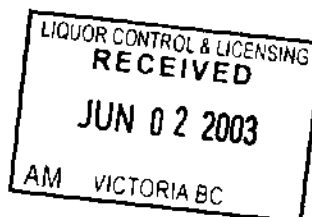
The Liquor-Primary Licence application and approval process

New applications:

1. The applicant must submit a complete application package and fee to Victoria Liquor Control and Licensing Branch Head Office.
2. The Liquor Control and Licensing Branch (LCLB) staff will review the application package for completeness and will advise the applicant by phone or mail, of any information/documentation required before the application can be processed.
3. LCLB staff will request your local liquor inspector conduct a site inspection and provide comments regarding your application.
4. LCLB staff will provide the applicant with a summary of their application requesting any comment or corrections before the application summary is forwarded to the relevant local government or First Nation.
5. Your local government or First Nation will be asked to provide a resolution commenting on your application. They have 90 days to respond and may ask for an extension of this period. The local government may also choose not to participate in the process but must provide a resolution explaining this decision.
6. Once a resolution has been received, LCLB will review the resolution and the application. If approved, the applicant will be asked to provide detailed plans to the branch for approval. The applicant will receive notification of this approval and be asked to go ahead with construction if necessary.
7. When construction has been completed, the applicant should contact the local liquor inspector for a final inspection of the establishment. If the establishment passes the inspection, the applicant will be asked to submit a licence fee to the Victoria branch and a licence will be issued.

Transfer of Ownership applications:

1. The applicant must submit a complete application package and fee to Victoria Liquor Control and Licensing Branch Head Office.
2. The Liquor Control and Licensing Branch (LCLB) staff will review the application package for completeness and will advise the applicant by phone or mail, of any information/documentation required before the application can be processed.
3. If everything is in order, the local liquor inspector will be contacted and the applicant will be required to participate in an interview with the inspector to discuss the terms and conditions of the licence.
4. The inspector will notify the Victoria LCLB Head Office that the interview was conducted and a licence will be issued.

The Liquor Control and Licensing Branch – Compliance and Enforcement Office in Kelowna are currently in receipt of a RCMP report and a Licensed Premises Check B085447 as a result of a contravention observed in your establishment on June 29th, 2013.

Brief Details:

On June 29th, 2013 the Osoyoos RCMP conducted an establishment inspection of the Sage and Sand Pub at 2:53 A.M. Once inside the establishment the officer observed approximately 10 persons inside which were identified by the licensee as employees who were being served a drink after work. The officer observed that the liquor was being still being served to the persons inside and noted that the establishment's service hours were finalized at 2:00 A.M. As a result of this check the RCMP issued your establishment with a copy of a Licensed Premises Check B085447 for the contravention that was observed.

A review of the Police Report has been made and as a result I have enclosed the following Contravention Notice B 009779 which identifies the following contravention.

1. Sec 44(3) LCLA Regulation – Allow person to consume liquor more than ½ hour after liquor service ends

This incident also is contravention of the terms and condition of your licence (Sec.12 (3) (c) LCLAct which states:

Hours of sale

You may sell or serve liquor at your liquor primary establishment only during the hours indicated on the face of your licence. You are also responsible for making sure your employees follow B.C.'s liquor laws and the terms and conditions of your license.

Penalties for these contraventions of the Liquor Act are as follows:

1. Sec 44(3) LCLA Regulation – Allow person to consume liquor more than ½ hour after liquor service ends: **4-7 days suspension of the liquor license, to monetary penalties ranging from 5-7000 dollars for a first contravention.**
2. Section 12(3) (c) LCLAct – Contravene term and condition of Licence: **1-3 day suspension and or monetary penalties ranging from 1-3000 dollars.**


The Liquor Control and Licensing Branch have a number of strategies at its disposal to encourage voluntary compliance to the Liquor Act Regulations by Licensees. Voluntary compliance is our objective. If the matter is significant enough and affects public safety then the Branch will move to taking Enforcement Action via the issuance of a contravention notice which is attached.

Currently a report is being submitted to Victoria to review possible compliance options.

In the meantime, please contact as me soon as possible so that a compliance meeting can be arranged at the earliest time possible. The purpose of a compliance meeting is to allow you the licensee to demonstrate what steps have been taken to ensure compliance with the L.C.L.Act and the terms and conditions of their Licence.

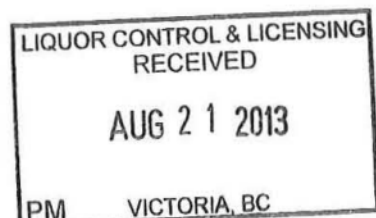

On June 29th, 2013 the Osoyoos RCMP conducted an establishment inspection of the Sage and Sand Pub at 2:53 A.M. Once inside the establishment the officer observed approximately 10 persons inside which were identified by the licensee as employees who were being served a drink after work. The officer observed that the liquor was being still being served to the persons inside and noted that the establishment's service hours were finalized at 2:00 A.M. As a result of this check the RCMP issued the establishment with a copy of a Licensed Premises Check B085447 for the contravention that was observed.

A review of the Police Report has been made and as a result a Contravention Notice B 009779 which identifies the following contravention was sent via registered mail.

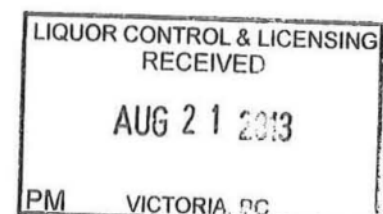
1. Sec 44(3) LCLA Regulation – Allow person to consume liquor more than ½ hour after liquor service ends. In the letter to the licence it identified to him that this event also was a contravention of the terms and condition of your licence (Sec.12 (3) (c) LCLAct which states: You may sell or serve liquor at your liquor primary establishment only during the hours indicated on the face of your licence. You are prohibited from selling or serving liquor – or using your establishment for any other purpose – between the end of liquor service and 6 a.m. All patrons must leave your liquor primary establishment within half an hour – one hour in some communities – of liquor service ending (it will be stated on the face of your licence if you are allowed one hour).

This contravention was reviewed with the local RCMP commander who advised that the establishment has been very cooperative with their summer policing program and wished to recommend that the Branch proceed via a compliance meeting. The licensee when contacted admitted they had made a mistake and knew better. A review of the compliance history showed that the licensee had no recent issues that had come to light.

On August 15th, 2013 a compliance meeting was held at the RCMP Detachment in Osoyoos. The meeting covered a wide range of topics including the contravention that initially started this process. The Police were satisfied with the meeting and the licensee who has been diligent in keeping his establishment in order.

No further action is required. File is now concluded.

If you could reply to this email with the address or city of the establishment in question, your email will be logged and forwarded to the Compliance and Enforcement office for that region so that a liquor inspector can investigate your observations. Your name and email address will be withheld from the licensee for your privacy. However, the inspector for that region may contact you if he or she requires more information.

For your information, you are correct about liquor pricing in bars, pubs, clubs and restaurants. They must be set at the beginning of the day and may not be altered during the business day, as in the practice of "happy hour" sales.
