Notes:

A case is counted as exhausted if it was in pay this month or last month and had earned income that exceeded the remaining AEE balance. This will exclude cases that have stopped receiving disability assistance for other reasons and whose AEE balance subsequently declined to zero.

A case that exhausts their AEE amount will not necessarily stop receiving assistance.
