  - probas for funding contracts post-bargaining (funding guide template -FGT)
    - ↳ set to 2010 standard + isn't even funded to that level.
  - FGT is outdated - eg 2014 agrmt - won't receive \$ till 6mos after had to pay at increase
  - service level reporting → long delays in being asked for info yrs after books are audited & closed.

- self-advocates on CIBC board
- voice of PWD has been ignored
- also looking for meaningful consultation - prev. wld give input but was ignored
- meaningful consultation = take the feedback & develop policy / plans accordingly - don't just implement pre-ordained plans regardless of feedback
- wld like an independent advocate for ppl w/ disabilities (like seniors & org)
