- main population in this Pitt Meadows area
(IR 1)

- no funding for youth or elder programming either from feds or province
- ppl who live on Reserve rarely access services from Friendship Ctrs, etc.
- social services - SW does one on one case work
- breakfast + lunch program → helps keep kids in school
 - attendance still prob.
- active cultural community means sometimes kids miss school for cultural traditions
- child care ctr includes lots of non-Indigenous kids - they grow up knowing Katzie
- used to have big prob of theft + vandalism
 - trained own security ppl - eliminated prob
 - same w/ maintenance & janitorial
 - now employ ppl & others have moved onto other jobs
- have substance use probs - police won't help

- what's needed: both \$ and support services
 - need people to provide services + \$ to pay them
- province provided \$30k for family support worker →
 - that's only a half-time job
- managed to get an add'l \$30k fr. MCDF.
- some troubled relationships w/ muni of Pitt Meadows
- not included in city planning discussions in any of the neighboring communities
- failing infrastructure - put in 100 yrs ago but never upgraded - INAC doesn't pay to fix so have to self-fund.
- advice to Minister?
 - hard to bring ppl home to FN w/out housing

- municipality not set up to provide MHA services

 - downtown - little choices of ppl who have very few options for improvement

- tried to provide washrooms but they were trusted
- library also affected - one of few places for ppl to go
- huge # ppl e river
- also increase in #s older ppl living in camps/ RV's - parking lots off or by river
