The podcast is called the <u>Confab Diary</u>, it was started by two people on opposite sides of the political spectrum and I'm sort of the unofficial third host. The format is basically hot political topics with pop culture mixed in, with generally it being about 30 minutes of an interview/chat with an elected official or other politically minded folks and then another 30 minutes of just the hosts talking about the hot issues in BC and abroad.
