




Filter FOUR Process – Filter One

Filter ONE – At Home Agency

- Work through the provided referral form
- Determine risk factors
- Establish that case meets AER guidelines
- Prepare de-identified presentation for BMART

Filter FOUR Process – Filter Two

Present case at BMART

Example of De-identified case presentation:

Non-Identified – 12-15 year old Youth – male

Truant from school 80% of the time. The school has attended the residence on 3 occasions to speak with his mother because she will not answer the phone. She looks out the window but will not come to the door. His father died 2 years ago. He has been involved in bullying another student at school when he attends.

The school has heard from other students that he started a garbage bin on fire at the mall several weeks ago.

Filter FOUR Process – Filter Two

Risk factors are identified and representatives discuss and determine if the case presented meets the criteria for Acutely Elevated Risk.

If No – Case is marked as REJECTED and the table moves on

If Yes – Case is moved to FILTER THREE

Filter FOUR Process – Filter Three

Presenting Agency shares Identifiable Information

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Address

Each agency present checks to see if they also have records pertaining to the individual/family at risk.

Filter FOUR Process – Filter Three

After each agency has determined their involvement, Risk factors are updated, and AER status is reviewed again.

If No, longer AER – Case is marked as REJECTED, the table moves on

If Yes, still AER – Case is moved to FILTER FOUR

Filter FOUR Process – Filter Four

The Table determines immediate action and risk mitigation is necessary and nominates the agencies who will participate in an organized response.

The agencies are recorded and discuss the case and response planning in a separate confidential meeting after the BMART is concluded.

The Four Filter Process

At every step of the process, a check should be made to ensure that the situation being brought to the BMART meeting meets ACUTELY ELEVATED RISK guidelines before proceeding.

This protects everyone involved in BMART, as well as the privacy of the individuals at risk.

It also confirms that sharing this information is in the best interest of the client, and is necessary for taking action for the reduction of the Acutely Elevated Risk.

Filter One

At your home agency – Use the provided BMART referral sheet to determine if the case should be brought to BMART.

Consider the following questions:

- Is AER met?
 - Can this be addressed with bi-lateral action alone?
 - Are there other options we haven't exhausted yet?
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Filter Two

Sharing at the BMART – Share de-identified information only

- Give age ranges only – NO specifics – e.g. Use child/children, senior, adult 30-35
 - No diagnoses – e.g. Use “suspected mental health issue” or “known physical disability”
 - Use generalised risk factors – e.g. Use “Substance Abuse” NOT “crack addict”
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Filter Three

Specifics Disclosed: Name - Date of Birth – Address

- Keep everything else as de-identified as possible.
 - Share only enough information to complete the risk factors and confirm AER is met
 - Specific details around diagnoses, case histories and intervention planning should not be discussed; these MUST be limited to Filter FOUR only.
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Filter Four

Only agencies necessary for AER mitigation are present.

Information is shared and recorded only in the best interest of the client to address the AER, and reduce potential harm.
