We scheduled a meeting with Susanna Laaksonen-Craig for next Wednesday 22 Aug in Victoria.

Before this meeting, I would like to have a 15 minute phonecall with you to discuss the goals and expectations of this meeting.

As you know, Old Massett is involved in negotiations regarding the LNG pipeline project.

They see the development of a Blue Carbon protocol which includes a section for Plankton Photosynthesis Stimulation as a vital component in this negotiation.

As a coastal First Nation band, Old Massett has been directly impacted by climate change resulting in significant declines of fish biomass and bio-diversity over the last decades. A process that will further impact them in the near future.

Sequestering CO2 through Plankton Photosynthesis Stimulation in Haida ocean waters allows Old Massett to develop an environmentally sustainable business which supports the local economy, creates local jobs, expands scientific knowledge of the oceans, increases bio-diversity and allows Old Massett to play an active role in offsetting CO2 emissions.

The expectation of Old Massett is that this meeting with the Climate Action Committee will result in concrete short-term actionable steps and timelines leading to a CO2 offset protocol for Plankton Photosynthesis Stimulation.
